Install the OneDrive App on your iPad.

In addition to accessing OneDrive files (including shared) from the dedicated App, OneDrive also nicely integrates with the native iOS Files App.

If this works anything like Google Drive, install Microsoft One Drive on your iPad from the iOS App Store.

In the One Drive app, there maybe a share area where other friends/family can share data with each other.

If the video is in .mp4 format, there should be an import option in the One Drive app or the One Drive app may have the normal iOS share icon ( a square icon with a vertical arrow through it ) that will allow you to share/download this video into the iOS Photos app.

The only place you can download .mp4 videos to ( if they are not commercial movies or TV shows ) is the iOS Photos app.

Since I do not use Microsoft One Drive, once you install this app into your iPad, you will need to figure out how this app works for uploading/downloading data back and forth from your iPad.

Were you able to access photos via iCloud prior to updating to Windows 10? Take a look at the resource below which explains the requirements and processes for iCloud Photo Sharing:

iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch using iOS 7 or later Mac using OS X Mavericks v10.9 or later and either iPhoto 9.5 or Aperture 3.5 Apple TV with Apple TV software 6.0 or later PC using Windows 7 or later and iCloud for Windows (or iCloud Control Panel 3.1 or later) iOS device: Go to Settings > iCloud > Photos and turn on iCloud Photo Sharing. Mac: Choose Apple menu > System Preferences. Click iCloud, then select Photos. Apple TV: Go to Settings > iCloud > iCloud Photos Settings and turn on Photo Sharing. PC: Open iCloud for Windows (or iCloud Control Panel) and select Photos. Click the Options button to verify that iCloud Photo Sharing is on and adjust the settings. Click Apply when you're done.

How were you downloading shared iCloud images to your PC before you upgraded to Windows 10? Did you use this method?

Open iCloud for Windows. Click the Options button next to Photos (or Photo Stream). Note the path listed under iCloud Photos location. Open a File Explorer window (Windows 8) or Windows Explorer window (Windows 7). Go to the iCloud Photos folder using the above path. Open the

Shared folder. Select the photos you want to save, then copy them to another folder on your computer. Include this folder if you back up your computer.

Question: Q: Duplicate folders iCloud for windows.

I just installed iCloud for Windows on my Windows 10 PC. After indicating it was preparing my library for a while, it then displayed a list of years in a dialog when I clicked Download. I selected 2017, and it created a \2017 folder and added some pictures to it. I then clicked Download again, and 2017 was not selected. I selected 2017 plus some other years. I've done this a few times now and I've ended up with duplicate folders containing duplicate files. I thought this was a syncing program? Is it just for downloading? Is that why it's creating these duplicate folders? Shouldn't it remember my download "years" or "all" selections? What is going on?

Download iCloud photos and videos.

With iCloud Photos, you can download a copy of your photos and videos on any device.

How to download photos and videos from iCloud.com

If you want to save copies of your photos and videos from iCloud.com to your iPhone, iPad, iPod touch, or your Mac or PC, follow these steps.

On your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch.

On iCloud.com, tap Photos. Tap Select, then tap a photo or video. To select multiple photos or videos, tap more than one. To select your entire library, tap Select All. Tap the more button . Choose Download, then tap Download to confirm.

If your photos download as a ZIP archive, learn how to uncompress the folder on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch.

On your Mac or PC.

On iCloud.com, click Photos and select a photo or video. Hold the command key on your Mac or control key on your PC to select multiple photos or videos. Click and hold the download button in the upper corner of the window. If you want to download your photo or video as it was originally captured or imported, choose Unmodified Original. For JPEG or H.264 format — including edits, and even if it was originally in HEIF or HEVC format — choose Most Compatible.\* Click Download.

If your photos download as a ZIP archive, learn how to uncompress the folder on your Mac or your PC.

What happens when you delete photos or videos.

Remember, when you delete a photo from iCloud Photos, it also deletes from iCloud and any other device where you're signed in with the same Apple ID — even if you turned on Download and Keep Originals or Download Originals to this Mac. If you choose to download your originals, this also impacts your device storage. Learn more about how to manage your device storage. You can also learn how to AirDrop your photos and videos to another device.

How to download photos and videos from the Photos app.

If you want to download a full-size copy of your photos and videos from the Photos app to your iPhone, iPad or iPod touch with iOS 10.3 or later or iPadOS, or your Mac with OS X Yosemite 10.10.3 or later, follow these steps.

On your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch.

Go to Settings > [your name]. Tap iCloud, then tap Photos. Select Download and Keep Originals.

On your Mac.

Open the Photos app. Choose Photos > Preferences. Select iCloud, then click Download Originals to this Mac.

On your PC.

If you're using a PC, you can set up iCloud for Windows and download a copy of your photos and videos from iCloud Photos.

Windows 10 Tip: Use the Photos App to Share Pics and Video.

Unlike in Windows 8, sharing photos to social media and other services in the new Windows 10 Photos app is much easier. Here's how.

Microsoft has made many improvements to its built-in universal apps, starting with version 1511, aka November Update, and one that has been worked on heavily is the Photos app. Unlike in Windows 8.1, sharing photos in the new Windows 10 app is much easier. Here's how.

Share Photos and Videos from Windows 10.

Use the Built-in Photos App.

First, launch the Photos app from the Start menu. Or, hit the Windows key and type photos, and click the top result.

Then, navigate to the picture or video that you want to share. Click the Share button on the top-right corner of the app. You can also right-click the image and select Share from the context menu.

Then you'll have different ways to share your media, i.e., social networks or email. Or, you to find an app in the Store.

You can share multiple items as well. Open a folder, album, or collection that contains the media you want to share and select each one you want.

Whichever app or service you decide to share your photos, follow the on-screen instructions for each one. In the example shown below, I'm sharing a picture using the Facebook app.

Another thing to point out is you can share photos or video albums. To do that, open the album you want to share, scroll down to the bottom and select Share this album. The album will be uploaded and created in OneDrive.

When it's ready to share, you can select an app to share it with or copy a link and paste it into an email or Twitter message.

Also, keep in mind that to share with services like Dropbox or Twitter that you'll need to be logged in to those services before you can share with them. If you're not, you'll get an error message.
