However, a word of advice: laptops are portable devices, so there's a reason for all those power-saving mechanics built into them

Personally, I would refrain from disabling them for any reason, EXCEPT in cases where they have distinct settings for "battery" and "connected to charger".

For your downloads, instead of making you laptop draw more/full power when you close the lid instead of turning off like one would expect, I suggest just leaving the lid open.

If your computer is asleep, all of your running programs are effectively paused in a suspended state, and Steam will definitely not download games. I did it last night and I can 100% confirm that, yes, they will download in sleep mode on PC.

Do games download in sleep mode Windows 10?

While sleep puts your work and settings in memory and draws a small amount of power, hibernation puts your open documents and programs on your hard disk, and then turns off your computer. So there no possibility to update or download anything during Sleep or in Hibernate Mode.

Is it bad to leave your PC on sleep mode?

You can put your PC to sleep to save electricity and battery power. Sleep isn't so good if you're planning to be away from the PC for extended periods, as the battery will eventually run down. When To Hibernate: Hibernate saves more power than sleep.

Do games keep downloading in sleep mode switch?

Yes, As long as you have the console on the dock [or not] and connected to the internet (with no other games running in the background), the console will download updates or games in sleep mode.

Can I leave my switch on overnight?

The Nintendo Switch console can be left in the dock while not in use to ensure that it is fully charged. Leaving the console on the dock or plugged in directly with the AC adapter overnight, or past the point where the battery is fully charged will not cause harm to the battery.

Do games download faster in sleep mode?

Though it was difficult to accurately collect results due sleep mode not having a method of viewing download progress, the number of tests seemed to prove that the sleep mode actually downloads games about 15% faster than if the console is in use.

Does sleep mode download faster PC?

Yes, to keep system in a low-power state all downloads stop in sleep mode. If you want your laptop to consume less power or continue downloads for long time, but don't want to put it in sleep mode, you can try reducing display time-out, brightness or simply toggling from balanced to power saver mode.

Can I turn off my ps4 while downloading a game?

You can. Just turn it off, move it, and when you turn it back in the download/install will resume.

Will ps5 download games faster?

How long will it take to download a game on ps5?

Windows resizing and relocating after sleep.

Following the major update that was applied on my PC on 19 Jan 2019 (build 10.0.17763), when my PC wakes up from sleep or even from the display just turning off and I click on apps that are minimized in the taskbar, the app windows are resized and snap to the upper left corner of the display. I then have to resize them and move them back where I want them.

Very annoying, as you might imagine. Other than that, my PC has been very stable on Windows 10 from Day One.

You can't install it if your computer is off, but you can download them in the background while you play other games on Steam.

Go to Steam>Settings>Downloads and check Allow downloads during gameplay .

Windows 10 Does not Update In Sleep Mode.

PCs in the office do not always download and install Windows updates when set to the default sleep timeout.

I was using the default Power settings for the PCs in the office. The PCs are left on 24/7. The default setting puts a PC to sleep after it is idle for 30 minutes. This is great for reducing power consumption in the office. But it seems to have the side effect that Windows Updates do not download and install automatically. With the Sleep timer at 30 minutes updates routinely seem not to happen. I often have to manually start the Update process, wait for the download, and restart the PC. I found that with the sleep timer set to 120 minutes the PCs would be updated and often the machine would restart without manual intervention. My take on this is that 30 minutes is sometimes insufficient for an Update to finish downloading. When the download is interrupted by Windows going to sleep it does not seem to resume but restarts at the beginning of the download. 120 minutes is enough time for even the largest update to download. Therefore, with that setting Update downloading is completed and the Patch is ready for the Restart.

That is my current theory on the issue of updates that never download. It begs the question as to why the downloads are not completed during the workday. So maybe this theory is wrong. But why did changing the sleep time seem to fix that?

Is my theory correct that PCs which go to sleep during an Update download never complete the download? Shouldn't the Update download in progress prevent sleep? Does a sleeping PC "wake up" to do a restart at the scheduled off hours time?
