Fortnite New Update Today: Patch Notes For PS4 (v2.93), Xbox One & Nintendo Switch Update.

We had a major Fortnite update last week with the release of v14.50. The update wasn't feature heavy like the v14.10 update at the start of the season. However, there was an item added that players have been waiting for quite some time to finally make a return to battle royale.

A jetpack was added to the game called the "Stark Industries jetpack". We haven't had a jetpack in Fortnite since chapter 1, and players that started playing in chapter 2 can finally take to the skies.

There was an issue with the PS4 Fortnite update not deploying due to an issue, which resulted in PlayStation players having to wait a few hours in order to download the new update.

Since then, there has been another update that was pushed out for PC players last Wednesday, which fixed some crashing issues. The update resulted in the Ghost Rider cup being delayed by an hour for European players.

Epic have announced on the official Fortnite Status account that a brand new Fortnite update has been pushed out today and here's what you need to know.

Today's new Fortnite update doesn't bring anything new to the game. The update is available on PS4 (v2.93), Xbox One and Nintendo Switch. According to Epic, the update was pushed in order to fix an issue with matchmaking portals in creative on the platforms stated above.

However, creative matchmaking portals have not been re-enabled yet, but we'll update this as soon as they're enabled.

We're almost at the end of Fortnite Chapter 2 Season 4, and we'll be getting the final update of the season next week, v14.60. After that, we should get a live event with Galactus finally landing on the map. There's no official date yet for the event, but it'll likely be during the final week of the season with the season expected to end on November 30th.

Fortnite Update 3.17 Patch Notes on May 27 | Maintenance Patch.

Epic Games is deploying Fortnite Update 3.17 right now for all the players and here are the full list of patch notes and changes coming to the game. There is a server maintenance going on which would push the new patch live for everyone. We saw the previous big update Fortnite v16.50 two days back, but that brought in some bugs that Epic Games acknowledged.

Since the servers are still down and scheduled maintenance is in progress, we do not have an update on the file size for the Fortnite PS4 Update 3.17. You should be able to download and install it as soon as the servers get back online.

Fortnite Update 3.03 Patch Notes | Hotfix Update.

Epic Games pushed out Fortnite Update 3.03 hotfix yesterday for the supported platforms and we have the complete patch notes. This patch is an important hotfix that fixes some important bugs that were missed out in the Fortnite v15.30 Update. You can download and install the patch right now in the game.

This patch covers the queuing bug with tournaments, and the recent performance issues with DirectX 12 on PC have also been fixed. Apart from them, there have also been some stability fixes for the PS5. The file size of this update is about 1.1 GB on the PS4, and about 747 MB on the PS5 version 1.000.013.

Patch download speed is incredibly slow on ps4 for me.

For some reason the patch is downloading at a snails pace (I'm talking kb/s). My Internet is fine and I can download a Bf patch at around 7mbs. Anyone know what's up, or how to fix it?

That's not your fault and not fixable either. At least from your side. Sony/PSN is reducing the internet speed with high demanded downloads. So there's no chance for a quicker download 'til the number of people downloading it goes down.

another tip to this problem is starting the download and putting the playstation in rest mode. heard its a lot quicker 'cause the ps can focus on the download and nothing else. furthermore check the manual setups for DNS and MTU options in the networksettings.

I have a ps4 since launch and i have never ever heard of that or seen that happen. Could you elaborate or provide a source?

I get incredibly frustrated by downloads on PSN. To have fibre on Ethernet with over 120mbps download for it to take 2 hours for a 1.5gb update is truly laughable.

Feel the exact same.

Same with mine. I dont know how to fix it.

It was the exact same for me. My bfl update installed really fast and the fortnite update took ages and then needed to copy when it was finished for whatever reason.

Same with mine, every patch. I just have to put it in rest mode. It really does make a difference.

Same. I downloaded the game in 20mins. Not its saying 3 hours for a 1gb patch :/

I pay for 300 Mbps down, and it says 5 hours remaining. Looks like I won't be able to play this game today.

I'm still waiting! It's killing me inside.

I stopped and restarted the download. twice. Download speed stilled crawled along. If it matters to you, I live in the central time zone and have 100mb down from my ISP. Had around 100 mb left and it said 24 minutes, this was about 7:00 am.

This isn't something that is fixable, this is just PS throttling down bandwidth or sheer number of downloads.

Far Cry 6 Leaks On PSN, Stars Breaking Bad's Giancarlo Esposito [Update]

The new Far Cry game is launching on February 18, and will feature free next-gen upgrades.

Update: Following the PSN leak, Ubisoft released an official short teaser for Far Cry 6, starring Breaking Bad's Giancarlo Esposito. The brief look teases an upcoming full reveal at Ubisoft Forward, which takes place on Sunday, July 12.

Original story follows.

The listing, which has since been taken down, sheds some light on the setting for Ubisoft's sequel. Far Cry 6 will take place in Yara, which is described as a tropical paradise in need of restoration to its former glory. Its ruthless dictator, Anton Castillo, and his son Diego are on a path to achieving that through any means necessary, igniting a revolution in the region.

Given the box art present in the listing, it's safe to assume that Esposito will likely be playing the role of Anton Castillo. The rest of the listing also sheds light on the upgrade path you can expect for next-gen consoles. Far Cry 6 will launch on PS4 and PS5 and offer a free upgrade for digital purchases should you move from an older console to a newer one. This is like how Microsoft is handling upgrades with Smart Delivery on the Xbox Series X, but Ubisoft has yet to confirm its support for the program.

According to the store page, Far Cry 6 is scheduled to launch on February 18, 2021. Ubisoft is hosting its Ubisoft Forward stream this Sunday, July 12, where you can expect to hear more about this and more Ubisoft titles such as Watch Dogs: Legion and Hyper Scape.
