How to Save Gmail Attachments on Android.

Saving Gmail attachments to your phone on Android used to be over-complicated, but since a major update to the Android app last year, it has become a whole lot easier. You no longer even need to be in the actual email thread containing the attachment to download it to your phone!

Here we're going to show you a couple of methods for saving Gmail attachments on Android.

The modern version of the Gmail app lets you directly access email attachments from your email inbox.

Note: your "Conversation list density" will need to be on Default or Comfortable to see attachments from the inbox. To change this, tap the hamburger menu icon at the top-left corner of Gmail -> Settings -> General settings -> Conversation list density, then change it to the relevant setting.

Now, back in your Gmail inbox you can see the attachments just under the email preview.

Tap the attachment to open it, then tap the three-dot menu icon at the top-right corner and click Save (or Save to Drive).

Alternatively, you can download attachments from inside the individual email thread. Just navigate to the exact email containing the attachment you want, then press the Download icon next to the attachment.

Once you've downloaded the Gmail attachment to your phone, it should be in your Downloads folder (or whatever you set as the default download folder on your phone). You can access this using the default file manager app on your phone (called 'Files' on stock Android), then navigating to the Download folder within that.

So, anyone knows the path where those attachments were downloaded into?

1 Answer 1.

You can check the following location to view the attachments:

In this location you'll see a random code something like cd8ca9801230132321232sd312312ad312.

Navigate to that folder and you would see few other folders named.

attachments avatars smart_hero_mail_image smart_mail_image.

To view the attachments, navigate to "attachments" folder. Here you'll find lot of folders with random name. Sort the folders based on date, so you could file the most recent ones on top/bottom. The attachments will be stored on random folders, based on when (date) you opened the files via Inbox application.

Open & download attachments in Gmail.

When you get an email with attachments, you can download a copy of the attachment to your device.

Download an attachment.

On your Android phone or tablet, open the Gmail app . Open the email message. Tap Download .

Download a photo from inside an email.

If a photo is inside an email message instead of added as an attachment, on your Android phone or tablet, open the Gmail app . Open the email message. Touch and hold the photo. Tap View image . Tap the photo. In the top right, tap More . Tap Save .

Save to Google Drive.

On your Android phone or tablet, open the Gmail app . Open the email message. Tap Save to Drive . When the message is saved, you'll see "Saved to Drive" on your screen.

Fix issues with attachments.

When you try to download an attachment, you might receive error messages, like:

How do I download PDF documents from Gmail?

When I receive a PDF attachment, the Gmail app only gives the option to preview it, not download. It opens in the default PDF reader (I have Adobe's reader).

How can I save the PDF instead?

3 Answers 3.

Attachment2SD will do the trick.

After you install it when you click on the PDF attachment in the Gmail app it'll pop-up the "Complete Action Using. " dialog. Choose Attachment2SD and it'll download to a directory on your SD card, where you can immediately open it or save it for later. This works with all kinds of files, not just PDF.
