How to install Minecraft Forge.

Minecraft Forge only works for the Java Edition, so if you're not living your best modding life on the original PC version, then there's plenty of fun to be had exploring Minecraft PE seeds to keep your busy for hours.

If you do have the Java Edition, then Minecraft Forge is a fantastic tool for managing every single one of your compatible mods. When approaching it for the first time, it can be a little daunting. But don't fret, we've created an easy step-by-step guide to installing Forge for Minecraft so you can quickly and seamlessly alter your Minecraft experience.

How to install Minecraft Forge.

You can install Minecraft Forge in these three easy steps:

Download Minecraft Forge at the official website. Make sure you double check your version, so you download the correct one. The list of versions can be found along the left hand side. Open the downloaded installer, which will bring up the installation process. Be sure to confirm with 'Install Client' still selected and click 'OK'. Open the Minecraft Launcher and change the profile to 'forge'. When the game loads, you'll see a new 'Mods' menu available at the start.

Now, you'll be able to access the 'Mods' folder, and install all your favourite addons to the game using Minecraft Forge.

What is Minecraft Forge?

Minecraft Forge is a free, open-source server and if you like having mods running in the game then you are going to want to get it installed!

It has been designed specifically so that Minecraft: Java Edition becomes compatible with community-created mods.

How to install Minecraft Forge.

Here is all you need to know about getting Microsoft Forge installed and ready to play:

Make sure you have Java installed and running and then head to the Minecraft Forge download page. "Latest" and "Recommended" are the two options that you will be given and going with the latter is the best bet as it is the less buggy option. Keep an eye on the chart under "Minecraft Version" as that will let you know that you are installing the correct version that is compatible with your edition of the game. Click on the "Installer" link, skip the advert that pops up when you can and then the installation process will begin. Run the install programme when prompted and allow it the permissions that it needs. A window will then appear and click "Install Client" and then "OK." Let the install do its thing and when it is done you will get another pop-up message that you just need to press "OK" on. Now open up Minecraft Launcher and open the drop-down menu next to "Play". From here, choose the version of Minecraft you want to play – in this case, it will be Minecraft Forge. Press play and then have a look to see if the "Mods" option has appeared – if it has, you're good to go!

How to add a mod into Minecraft Forge.

Forge may be able to run mods, but do not expect there to be loads in there when you start as there will actually be zero – you need to find them yourself.

To do so, visit a Minecraft Mod site such as minecraftmods.com and you will be spoilt for choice with the number of mods there to get your hands on.

Choose the one that you want and save it to the Forge folder on your PC or Mac – it will have been created when you installed Forge. Now click the “Mods” tab on the “Minecraft” main menu to make sure that the mod you have chosen is enabled and if it is, you’re all done!

Now just enjoy Minecraft Forge with all the mods you could possibly want!

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How to use Minecraft Forge.

Minecraft Forge guide: How to use it and manage all your blocky mods.

If you've got a lot of mods to manage, Minecraft Forge is what you need to download. While Mojang's blocky survival game continues to stand the test of time in its vanilla form—especially with the first part of the Minecraft Caves and Cliffs update live now—Forge is a great way to make managing your Minecraft mods simpler.

That means new biomes, structures, and more, all at your fingertips. So, whether you're already up to your ears in mods or you're looking to get started in Minecraft's modding scene, here's how to install the software, how to use Minecraft Forge, and what it does.

Minecraft Forge: What does it do?

Modding can be quite a difficult process in some games, but Minecraft Forge makes it all relatively simple. Once you have installed the Forge client, you'll be able to select it as a profile on your Minecraft launcher which then adds a button that lets you view a list of your mods.

From here you can select the mods you want to use and launch the game as usual. Or if you've just downloaded a new mod, you can open the mods folder by clicking on the button at the bottom of the list. This allows you to copy a newly downloaded mod to the mods folder without having to search for the location manually.

How to install Minecraft Forge.

First, head to [Minecraftforge](https://minecraftforge.net) and download the program. Make sure that you download the version of Forge that corresponds to the version of Minecraft you have (if Minecraft is 1.1, download the 1.1 version of Forge). Go to the downloaded file (it should be at 'C:\Users\[username]\AppData\Roaming\.minecraft\mods') and open. Note: If you can't run the installer, check you have Java installed. Select 'Install Client' then hit 'OK'. Open Minecraft and change the profile to 'forge'. Once the game loads, you'll see a new 'Mods' menu on the start screen. Click this and choose which mods to use.

That's all there is to it. Now it's just a simple matter of finding the Minecraft mods you like and installing them.

Minecraft Forge: How to Download, Install, and Use Forge.

If you are reading this article you probably already know Minecraft. We use Forge to manipulate the game Minecraft to make it do what we want. This could be anything, ranging from new cool creatures to entire new systems in the game.

Forge is a modding API. Minecraft Forge (or Forge for short) is a layer between our code and Minecraft itself.

We cannot directly ask Minecraft to add items and do special cool things. That's why we need an API (application programming interface) to handle our logic and make Minecraft recognise it.

Sounds cool! How do I get started?

You'll need the JDK (Java development kit) which is a set of libraries, tools and the runtime environment to make Java programs and run them. A Minecraft account which can be bought from their official website. (<https://minecraft.net/en-us/store/>) An IDE (Eclipse or IntelliJ are recommended for Minecraft development)

After installing/acquiring these pieces of software, download your desired Forge version at <https://files.minecraftforge.net/>.

Tip : Hover over the information button and press direct download to avoid an Adfly virus!

Once you have downloaded this ZIP you'll be able to unzip it. Do so and cd (cmd/command) into the directory with all of the Forge files. Run `gradlew setupDecompWorkspace` .

Next up is picking your IDE (integrated development environment).

Eclipse? `gradlew eclipse` . IntelliJ? Import the build.gradle file in your IntelliJ setup.

Okay now what? How do I add fancy new items? (Basic mod setup)

Hold your horses. There's much more to it. You'll have to texture an item of course, add code and so much more! In this article we'll only look at some simple sample code which I also use for my own mods. Here it is!

@Mod.EventBusSubscriber @Mod(modid = Version.MOD ID, name = Version.MOD NAME, version = Version.VERSION) public class TheMod.

Use this code as you please. Just make sure you edit, for instance, the proxy strings and more. This should give you a basic overview of what a basic mod class looks like.

TIP! You can keep multiple mod files inside the "mods" folder. You can also make a separate folder inside the mods folder to "hide" unused mods.

Optifine is a Minecraft optimization mod that allows users to load custom shaders & graphics. It can be used to load custom shaders and graphical improvements to change the overall appearance of Minecraft.

Also Optimizes Minecraft.

Players may also notice a significant boost in FPS once OptiFine is installed. This can be due to the optimization that the mod introduces. This can be very helpful if you're running demanding mods .

Most Shaders Require OptiFine.
