How do I get the Facebook Messenger app on my Samsung Galaxy device?

Facebook Messenger connects to your Facebook account so that you can easily message all of your friends. Through the Messenger app you can send messages, start group conversations, share photos, videos and gifs and make voice and video calls.

Please note: if you have trouble with an app we recommend contacting that app's developer. Third-party applications are not supported by Samsung. Visit the Facebook website for a list of their FAQs.

Please note: you will need to have enough spare memory on your device. You can clear space on your device by deleting apps you don't use or by moving some data to an SD card.

Facebook Messenger is supported on devices that meet the following requirements:

the smartphone is running Android 4.0 or later. Find out how to check what Android version you are using.

Additionally, you will need a mobile data plan in order to recieve and send messages when outside of a Wi-Fi network Please note: Messenger is no longer supported on devices running Android 2.3 or older. If you are using a device on Android 2.3 you can download the Messenger Lite or Facebook Lite apps. You can also view your messages on the Facebook website.

How to Auto-Save Photos and Videos on Facebook Messenger: All you need to know.

Here is the step by step guide to automatically save the photos and videos received on Facebook Messenger.

The photos and videos received on Messenger from your friends are not been saved automatically by default, messenger needs an option to be turned on to download them. Also when you capture a new picture or record a video using the Facebook Messenger and send it to another user the picture or video won't be saved to your device automatically.

Facebook Messenger does give you the option to automatically save the photos. However, it does need to be turned on manually.

Here's how to auto-save photos and videos on Facebook Messenger:

Open the Facebook Messenger application. Click on your profile photo in the upper left corner. Now Select 'Photos and Media'. Tap the toggle switch to enable Save on capture.

Here's how to auto-save photos and videos from Facebook Messenger on iOS:

Open Facebook Messenger application. Now click on the Settings gear icon. Scroll down in Settings to find "Save Photos to Camera Roll" Now flip the switch to the ON position.

Use these methods any time you want to save a picture from Messenger to your device. If you want all pictures in Messenger to save

automatically, see saving photos automatically. All incoming photos will now save to your device.

How to Stop Facebook Messenger from Auto-Saving Photos.

The Facebook Messenger has an option to automatically save all photos sent to your phone. This feature can be helpful so your phone won't need to download photos everytime you open your device's Messenger. However, the photos can accumulate over time. These photos can take up your phone's space. Also, auto-downloaded photos make it hard for users to find photos to upload. This article will discuss how to stop Facebook Messenger from auto-saving photos to your phone.

Automatic saving of photos can be a headache for Facebook Messenger users with limited internal storage on their devices. These photos can eat up a considerable chunk of your phone's space giving some serious storage issues. Fortunately, there is a way to disable the auto-saving of photos on your Facebook Messenger.

Method 1: Disable Automatic Saving of Photos on Facebook Messenger Using iPhone.

To turn off the auto-save feature on Facebook Messenger using your iPhone, follow these procedures:

1. Open your Facebook Messenger app on your iPhone. 2. With the Messenger opened, tap on your profile icon located on the upper-left part of the screen. 3. From your profile, scroll down to the bottom part of the screen. 4. Tap on the Photos, Videos & Emoji option. 5. Turn off the switch for Save to Camera Roll option. A grey switch means that the feature is turned off. Once turned off, photos and videos on your Facebook Messenger won't automatically save to your phone. Once switched off, automatic saving of photos on your iPhone is disabled.

Method 1: Disable Automatic Saving of Photos on Facebook Messenger Using Android.

If you are an Android user, follow these steps to disable automatic saving of photos on Facebook Messenger:

1. Launch your Android's Facebook Messenger app. 2. From Messenger's user interface, tap on your profile icon on the upper-right part of the screen. 3. From your profile, scroll down to the bottom part of the screen. 4. Tap on the Photos & Media option. 5. Tap on the switch to the right of Save Photos . A blue-colored or green-colored switch means that the feature is turned on while a grey switch means that it is turned off. Once switched off, automatic saving of photos on your Android device is disabled.

Frequently Asked Questios.

Q: After disabling the auto-save feature on my phone, will my device delete all the saved Messenger photos on it? A: Turning off Facebook Messenger from auto-saving photos will not delete previously saved photos on your phone. This means that the saved photos are untouched and that you need to manually delete all of them if you wish to clear your phone off of those unnecessary files.

Q: Is there a disadvantage when you turn off the auto-saving feature? A: There are quite a few disadvantages when you turn off the auto-save photos on Facebook Messenger. For one, conversations with photos may take longer to load every time you close and open your app as these photos would need to be downloaded from the source again. Also, viewing of photos on Facebook Messenger will require internet as the files would need to be downloaded again. Lastly, constant repetitive download of pictures and videos consumes bandwidth. If your internet plan is not unlimited, you may want to monitor the app's data consumption.

Auto-saving of photos from the Messenger has its own set of advantages and disadvantages. Now that you know how to disable Facebook Messenger from auto-saving photos, and the advantages and disadvantages of turning off the feature, we hope that you can now assess what works for you.
