## Things to Consider When Evaluating Free POS Software:

Some free software cannot process large payments smoothly and encounter bugs or delays as a result. If you have customers that use different currencies, you will need POS software that accommodates this. Some free software has limited features or tools, so it is essential to find out if the free software will cover all of your business' needs. Saving money on POS software in the short term may lead to longer periods of time spent manually processing payments. Consider how user-friendly the software is and how the user interface looks and feels, because some free POS software, packed with features as they may be, are just simple programs with little thought given to design and user experience.

What is the difference between open source and free POS software?

Free POS software can be used without paying for it, but changes to its source code can't be made. Open-source POS software can be customized by making changes to the source code which has been made public by the software developer.

Square vs. Loyverse vs. eHopper:

For businesses looking for free POS, Square, Loyverse, and eHopper are great options. In terms of user experience, they are on a par, all offering

clean, easy-to-use interfaces. Only a few things set them apart.

Square is the most secure of the three. It offers advanced security features and processes payments. Loyverse uses only third-party processors, which can undermine security, and eHopper, while it does process payments, has only basic security features.

eHopper can be used on more platforms. Square and Loyverse can be used on any iOS and Android mobile devices, but eHopper is completely operating system agnostic. It can be used on iOS and Android devices, but also on PC.

Loyverse offers the best customer support. Loyverse's live chat is incredibly helpful. Response times are rapid. Square offers good support, but there have been problems in the past, and eHopper offers full support with their paid packages only.

If you're looking for a good loyalty program, go with Loyverse or Square. Loyalty programs are essential these days for building customer relationships and both Square and Loyverse offer great built-in programs. eHopper has CRM features but is lacking a loyalty program in its free software.

Loyverse and Square are also expandable. Through a host of add-ons and other free apps, Loyverse and Square can expand on functionality. eHopper is very capable but offers no add-ons. Square also offers over 100 integrations, whereas eHopper, only one. Loyverse has none, but is currently working on an API.

Incoming by SalesVu for iOS.

INCOMING is a comprehensive iPad-based Order Manager and Kitchen Display System for your restaurant. This app allows your front counter staff and/or kitchen staff to view all incoming dine-in, pickup, and delivery orders in real time.

Your team members can then mark each order as either In-Progress (so that customers can view from your branded-app or website that the order is being worked on), mark them as Ready (so that food runners or delivery drivers know to come get it at the kitchen counter), or mark them as In-Transit, Delivered, or Picked-up depending on whether the orders was placed as a dine-in, pickup, or delivery order.

The app works in conjunction with:

- Your own restaurant-branded ordering app (also provided by SalesVu),
- The OrderUp customer self-ordering kiosk app,
- The SalesVu iPad POS app,
