Crossfire is the biggest title in Asia when it comes to FPS games. It was developed by Tencent and became the highest grossing game of 2014. The rest of the world is not quite as crazy about the game but the Asian market was excited to see Crossfire: Legends hit the shelves.

Gameplay.

The graphics are probably the first thing that you'll notice about Crossfire: Legends for PC. While most game developers are concentrating on making their games look glamorous, Tencent decided that they'll make their graphics look like they were designed for a game from the early 2000s. The result is a gaming experience that looks retro and responds well as you play through PvP game modes which include Battle Royale, Demolition and Team Deathmatch.

Team Deathmatch is exactly what it sounds like- players form opposing teams and the team with the most kills is the winner. This is the game's best feature and is good for hours of mindless fun. Players can choose from one of three different maps.

Battle Royale Mode has all of the standard features that you'd expect. This means you can play solo, as a team or as a duo while you participate in a last-man-standing melee using weapons such as SMGs, rifles, pistols and shotguns. Loot is dropped from the sky so that you can restock on ammo and health.

Demolition mode features two teams. One team is tasked with planting a bomb on one of the two bomb sites while the opposition is tasked with defusing the bombs. If you have ever played Counter-Strike before, this game mode will be familiar.

Players will notice many other similarities between this game and Counter-Strike. For example, one of the maps in Crossfire: Legends is almost identical to de-dust2 which was the most popular map in Counter-Strike. Thankfully, the similarities end there.

Unlike in Counter-Strike, players in this game are able to choose their loadouts before the match starts instead of buying them when the round starts. Game currency is used to upgrade those weapons as you advance through the game. The upgrades are not particularly powerful but you are still better off with them than without them.

The Good.

The retro graphics that emulate Counter-Strike are well-implemented. You can enjoy the game without feeling like the graphics could have been better.

The Bad.

Many of the items you can buy as upgrades are purely cosmetic. Most of them add very little, if any, value to your arsenal.

Conclusion.

Crossfire: Legends is a great game to play. The only issue is that, like many games made for the Asian market, it is a rehash of existing games that does not add anything new to the world of mobile gaming. The only differences that the developers made were making the Battle Royale fit 120 players instead of 100 and using a sandstorm instead of a blue circle to mark the map's edges.

If you are looking for a gaming experience similar to Counter-Strike, this is the game for you. The fast-paced gameplay and retro feel while you shoot at your enemies are certain to keep you entertained.

After Smilegate released Crossfire in 2007, this game quickly became one of the best FPS game, arguably one of the most popular FPS games around the globe. The game is well-known for its lightweight yet realistic graphics, beautiful and smooth effects, and a variety of game modes and weapons systems. Not only that, you can experience the environment as in the real army.

Despite some rumours for a long time, the player has to wait until now to experience the English version of Crossfire: Legends after Tencent acquired the copyright from Smilegate. I quickly download and play, I feel that the game retains the charms of the PC version, but has been greatly improved to fit the mobile platform.

Introduce.

The first time you play Crossfire: Legends, you will be instructed by a beautiful and seductive girl. If you've ever played the PC version, you will easily recognize this girl as the Fox character, one of the most attractive female characters in the game. Unlike the PC version, the Mobile version has a pretty picky story about a battle between the members of the task force with evil enemies.

The dual control mechanism makes it easy to control the movement of the characters and to use the weapons in the game in the smoother manner. The game optimizes the look and feels of the virtual keyboard on the phone screen, allowing the player to control the game without obscuring the view. Still, it's a bit difficult to play FPS games on a mobile platform, that's hard to control with many players, but you'll get used to after a few games.

Familiar modes.

You will still be involved in familiar modes that have become the brand of Crossfire: Legends such as Team Match, C4, Single Match, Zombies and even Rank. The ranking system is similar to League of Legends, you have to try hard each match to get the highest ranking.

Moreover, you will experience the familiar maps such as Death crossroads, Pyramid, Cargo ship or Ancient arena. Also, the game also updates more interesting maps to discover.

New Mode: Survival.

Maybe you know Tencent is also the official publisher of PUBG and PUBG Mobile, so adding survival mode to Crossfire: Legends is also easy to understand. In this mode, you will enter the war of survival with 99 other players. The "last man standing" rule, ie only the one surviving player, is the winner. You know what to do? Killing all to become the winner.

Weapon system.

The game features all the weapons you've ever like, such as MG3, M4A1, AK, AWP, Desert Eagle, Thompson, Gatling gun, and even melee weapons such as shovels, axes, katana. Moreover, these weapons also have special upgrades such as Thompson Gold, Desert Eagle Born Beast or Dragon weapons collection. Of course, the better the weapon, the higher its value, even some weapons you have money can't buy but can own them by luck. I like Barret because of the huge gun damage, which is very suitable for Zombie mode.

Graphics and sound.

I'm impressed with the graphics of Crossfire: Legends because of the incredible authenticity. The game uses QuickSilver technology to make the 3D graphics bright and realistic and makes you think this is not a mobile game. The interface is designed in harmony, allowing you to easily control as well as observe around without obstacles. You should use a high-end phone to make the game experience smoother.

Sound effect also is advantages of this game. The characters are voiced 100% complete, the sound of guns, explosive bombs very similar to in real life. You will enjoy listening to the orders of the characters or when they say Double Kills, Tripple Kills, Multi Kills, ...

CrossFire: Legends is the official Android version of the classic game CrossFire -- one of the world's top FPS titles ever. This time around (along with your standard PvP mode) you'll find there's a new variant on gameplay including a full 'Battle Royale' arena where you face off against over 120 players armed to the teeth. Play solo mode, in 2p games or in groups of up to 4 players.

Along with the seemingly endless number of game modes that Crossfire: Legends you'll find there are several classics including Deathmatch, minesweeper mode and much more. Pick from over 20 different modalities including parts where players morph into mutants, or opt for mission mode where you venture out on a quest while gunning down the hordes of enemies that pop up on screen as you go.

The main appeal in this game is that it works on any device, regardless of how meager it might be. Plus as it runs on Android 4.0 or higher and requires little over 1GB of RAM, you'll enjoy without overtaxing your smartphone's resources. Including on 'Battle Royale' mode you'll enjoy over 60fps that'll remain stable throughout. The other awesome feature is that CrossFire: Legends runs perfectly well without an internet connection. In fact, in offline mode you'll be playing against AI bots that are fully customizable, choosing from varying levels of difficulty.

In 'Battle Royale' mode players start out on an airplane. A second later will have you jumping off of the aircraft and parachuting your way downwards to a specific spot on your map. The name of the game is to survive and become the last man standing, so you've probably already guessed that being the first to grab as many weapon and ammo crates is key in your survival tactic. Plus, again there's a deadly blue forcefield that spans out and reduces as you play, adding in another potential threat. The rest of the game modes are based on standard FPS gameplay, but you can still opt in to switching up your settings to your preferences.

CrossFire: Legends is a fun game where you play in solitary mode as well as against other online players. Best of all is that despite the 'Battle Royale' mode being its main appeal, there's also a fine PvP mode just like the original CrossFire: Legends game.

In the world of videogames, sometimes we tend to be a bit shortsighted when it comes to evaluating the top games in the industry on a global level. After all, a game that's a smash hit in Asia, may end up being unknown in the west, just like we mentioned a while ago with Crossfire. On Android, the geographical disparity is even more drastic since there are marketplaces that are exclusive to Asia like Quooapp and TapTap.
