Apex Legends Crossplay: How to Turn Off Crossplay and Guide of Choosing Platform

From the past few months, a few questions are asked: Can we crossplay in Apex Legends? How to disable crossplay? How about cross-progression? Further, which platform is the best to play on? What's the difference between Steam and Origin?

In this article, all of the questions above will be answered. No doubt, we have seen a massive increase in the popularity of Apex Legends. Millions of players are grouping in EA's battle royal game, and it is quite clear why they like it so much. It is a free-to-play game with some quality graphics and gameplay. This game's core is based around looting and shooting, and it offers a few interesting twists in the battle royal format.

In this article, these questions will be answered:

In this battle royal game, you are a part of a 3-person squad. There are 14 playable characters to choose from, and they are called legends in the game. If you compare all legends, you will find that they are equal in strength, speed, and firepower. It's their special abilities that make them different from each other. Every character has a unique ability that can help you in-game to leverage other players. So, you can choose a legend that suits your playstyle and is a perfect fit for your squad.

Teamwork is very critical in this game. When you jump into the battleground, there are two teammates on your side. Make sure to stick with them during the match if you want to win it. By working together, you can protect each other and outmatch the enemies by combining your abilities. You can stay connected with your teammates using the in-game communication system. You can mark different locations, highlight threats, pinpoint the location of gear pieces, and tell your teammates in which direction you are going.

There is a ring around the battleground that shrinks after fixed short intervals. As the ring shrinks, it forces the players into a smaller space on the map, and as a result, we observe more fights between different teams. If you want to win the game, then you have to be the last team standing. If your teammates are knocked down, then you can revive them and pick them up. If they are completely killed, you can pick up their banner in a fixed amount of time and have them jumped back into the game once again. This feature makes this game different from other battle royal games where if your teammate dies once, then he stays dead the rest of the game.

One thing that you must keep in mind while playing this game is that killing an opponent is a bit longer than other FPS (First Person Shooting) games. To kill an opponent, you may need to rely on several headshots, your legends' unique ability, and the support of your teammates.

Although this game is free of cost, it offers several in-game purchases. You can purchase Apex Coins, which is an in-game currency.

You can use it to purchase loot boxes that contain skins and costumes. There are two locked characters in the game also, and you need to purchase them with Apex coins. So, you can get the maximum out of this game by spending some money and giving time to this game.

Can Apex Legends crossplay or not?

Yes, Apex Legends is a cross-platform game. Initially, it wasn't a cross-platform game, but Apex became a cross-platform game after an update in autumn 2020. It means that two players playing on two different devices can group in a squad and play the game. Let's explain it with an example. Suppose you have a pc and your friend has a PS4. Both of you can play together in a squad, even if you both have two different types of devices.

How to turn off crossplay?

Firstly, crossplay is enabled by default. Assume now you're playing apex on PS4/switch/Xbox using a controller, you might be reluctant to crossplay against a PC player using keyboard and mouse. Because you might think that isn't fair. So why don't we turn it off and play only with game console players?

Step1, to disable it, you need to go to the setting button at the lobby's right bottom, as shown below.

Step 2, under the gameplay tab, scroll down, and you can find cross-platform play.

Does it have cross-progression?

Unfortunately, because of technical and legal issues, no. It means that your characters/purchased items will not be synced through platforms. Simply put, you will have to start all over again if you change your platform.

Which platform is the best to play on?

The best thing about Apex Legends is that it has multiplatform support. You can play it on different platforms like:

Microsoft Xbox One S and X.

You can play Apex Legends on Xbox One S, but you may need to compromise a little bit and play on a low resolution for better fps. Although the game will run just fine, you may need to make some adjustments to your graphics settings. You can play this game on 720p on Xbox One S, so make sure to sit a little closer to your screen to see everything.

If you want to get Apex's best experience on Xbox consoles, you should play it on Xbox One X. If you switch from Xbox one S to Xbox one X, you will see a significant difference in the game performance. On the X version, you can run the game on 1080p. It offers overall better performance in terms of gameplay as compared to other Xbox variants.

Xbox Series X and S.

Xbox series S and X are the latest generations of Xbox. They rival their competitor PS5 and offer competitive performance when you compare these consoles with a PS5. They do offer better gaming performance and better graphics. But, the question is, Can you play Apex on the latest generations of Xbox? The answer is yes. You will get better performance in terms of graphics and FPS but currently, the game isn't fully optimized for the latest generations. In the coming days it is expected that the game will be optimized for the latest consoles and you can enjoy the game to the fullest. Currently, you can enjoy 1440p gaming on these consoles and can get up to 120fps.

Sony PlayStation 4.

You can also play Apex Legends on Sony PlayStation 4. Although you can play it on the standard PS4, if you want to get the best gaming experience, then you should play it on PS4 Pro. On PS4, you need to have a PlayStation Plus subscription if you want to play online multiplayer games, but in the case of Apex Legends, you do not need it.

Sony PlayStation 5.

Sony PlayStation 5 is a next-generation console, and luckily Apex Legends is already playable on it. PS5 offers improved performance and better graphics as compared to its previous versions. If you were previously playing on PS4 and just switched to PS5, you can also retain all your progress and skins on PS5 also. You can use the same EA account and start enjoying Apex Legends on 1440p screen resolution.

PC.

If you want to do competitive gaming in Apex Legends, then PC is the most suitable choice for you. It is because when you play using a mouse and keyboard instead of controllers, then your aim and movement are more precise. As it is an FPS category game, you can use a monitor with a high refresh rate to have smooth gameplay and reduce the lag. You must keep in mind that you need a PC with some good specs that can provide you with at least 60fps in the game. It would be best if you aim for a PC that can provide you maximum fps. 120 is the most recommended figure here.

Apex Legends: How to Turn Aim Assist On or Off.

In an FPS, most battles are decided by which player has the best aim. If you're using a mouse and keyboard, you'll usually get an advantage over controller players, which presents a challenge to balance the game across platforms. In Apex Legends, controller players are compensated with a built-in aim assist system that slightly nudges your cursor towards the target you're aiming at. However, aim assist can get it wrong sometimes and cause you to shoot at a different target than you intended.

If you think aim assist is not the best system for you, we have good news! You can quickly turn off aim assist in the game's settings. Find out how in this article.

How to Turn Off Aim Assist in Apex Legends?

If you're using a console, or you've plugged a controller into the PC, the game detects a controller and automatically turns on aim assist for your Apex Legends matches. While aim assist as a whole is usually a net positive and helps players more than it causes problems, some might prefer a more natural approach without AI aids. Thankfully, if you're one of those players, you can turn aim assist off in two different ways, both of which are quite simple.

Follow these steps to turn off aim assist in advanced controls:

Open the game's "Settings" menu. Go into the "Controller" tab on the top. Scroll all the way down. One of the last lines should read "Advanced Look Controls..." Open it. In the advanced controls, scroll down until you see "Targeting Assistance." Turn that setting to "OFF." If you want to re-enable aim assist later, turn "Targeting Assistance" on again.

The advanced look controls are also a great way to customize your input and control how much your character turns when you move the joysticks. There are various options to tinker with, so you can spend some time acquainting yourself with the process.

You can use the Firing Range to test out the new settings without aim assist. For more effect, you can use the Firing Range AI easter egg to turn DUMMIEs into moving combatants to get a better semblance of a real game.

There's another method to use to turn off aim assist, but some players might have a harder time adjusting to this change. Here's what you need to do:

Go into controller settings ("Settings" > "Controller" tab). In the "Look Sensitivity," set the slider to 8 (the highest value).

The highest sensitivity isn't actually much different than the lower one (7), with the only notable difference being that it completely removes aim assist. If you want to re-enable aim assist later, turn the setting to anything other than 8.

Playing on a console without aim assist initially might cause you to miss some shots that were previously possible. With a combination of weaker hardware than PC and aim assist as a genre staple to ensure competitive gameplay, players without aim assist are usually considered disadvantaged. However, if you're dedicated to learning the game and have excellent coordination and controller settings, you should be able to bridge the gap.

Additional FAQ.

How Strong Is the Aim Assist in Apex Legends?

Since aim assist is primarily used to bridge the gap between mouse + keyboard and console players, some people consider using a controller on the PC to be the best of both worlds. PCs most often have better hardware than consoles, allowing them to display sharper graphics and more detail that make aiming easier. This means that using a controller with its built-in aim assist should give you more of a competitive edge since it corrects for smaller aim discrepancies.

Unfortunately, not everything is built equally, and aim assist is no exception. Actually, the aim assist is a scale that goes from 0 to 1 in game files (with 1 being strongest), although we haven't quite figured out how much "1" does. For the PC version, the aim assist is set to 0.4, while the console versions use 0.6 settings. This discrepancy is presumably to counteract the consoles' lower graphics settings.

Should You Turn Off Aim Assist?

Aim assist is a hotly debated topic among not only Apex players, but FPS enthusiasts in general. It's not available for the mouse and keyboard, giving a slight advantage to console players. PC players might think it's unfair for a subset of players to get a better aim. However, the mouse + keyboard combination still has vastly superior recoil and movement controls to more than make up for it.

If you're wondering whether to turn off aim assist, we highly recommend following our instructions and at least trying out the Firing Range without aim assist. You should see a notable difference in how your character responds to input and how many shots you can hit.

How Do I Turn On Aim Assist on Apex Legends?

If you're using a controller to play the game and haven't tinkered with any of the settings, aim assist is automatically turned on.

When you're playing with a mouse and keyboard, there's no way to turn on aim assist.

How Do I Turn My Aim Assist Back On?

If you have changed your controller settings, you can turn aim assist back on again with the same settings. For "Advanced Look Controls," turn on the "Targeting Assistance" setting. If you've set the "Look Sensitivity" to max value (8), simply turn the setting back down to anything lower.

Can You Play Apex Legends With a Controller?

When playing the game on the consoles (PlayStation, Xbox, or Switch), your only option is to plug in a controller. However, if you're a PC player, you can play either with a mouse + keyboard combo or with a controller of your choice.

When you plug in a controller in a PC, the game will turn on aim assist as long as you only play with the controller. There's no way to trick the game into using aim assist alongside a mouse and keyboard. Any changes that allow you to auto-lock to targets this way is cheating.

What Controller Should I Use on Apex Legends for PC?

If you already have a console controller, then we recommend using whatever you currently own. Most PS4, PS5, and Xbox controllers are compatible with PCs and have dedicated Windows control settings to smoothly switch from console to PC gameplay.

Once you've set up the controller, you can customize your button layout in the "Settings" menu, and turn off aim assist if you really don't like the feature. Overall, we highly recommend playing on the PC with a mouse and keyboard and leaving the controller to consoles. Since aim assist is stronger on consoles, they get a slight edge over PC controller players.

Aim Down Some Destruction in Apex.

Aim assist is an FPS genre staple, appearing in many games to balance between PC and console gameplay. If you think you can outcompete opponents using a mouse and keyboard on a controller without the automated aim assist, feel free to try it out and report your findings.

Why Does Apex Legends Keep Crashing? 18 Potential Causes and Fixes.

Persistent crashes in Apex Legends can happen to anyone. You can have a high-end PC and enjoy beautiful graphics or a PC that barely meets the minimum game requirements. Even if your Internet is sufficient for playing online games, all of this is irrelevant when the game shuts off and you get sent to the desktop. And when you can't play at all, you can't get better at Apex Legends. But why does Apex Legends keep crashing? We can't say for certain. That's why we compiled the list of things that are the likely culprit. Any of them, or a combination of two or more, could turn out to be the answer.

Clarification.

Our guide will focus on Windows 10. Consoles restrict your options to very basic troubleshooting steps, and your best option is waiting for an update. Also, we assume you restarted your computer and Apex Legends itself and that you reinstalled the game. Also, we assume your hardware isn't decades old. Your CPU needs to support the required instruction set and your GPU should support DirectX 12.

1. Download the newest drivers.

To start from a clean slate, download and use a tool such as Display Driver Uninstaller . Then, follow these steps based on the GPU you have:

Visit the AMD Drivers & Support or Nvidia Drivers. Select your GPU from the list. Pick the latest driver, download, and install it.

2. Download a slightly older driver version.

Even if it says it's a Stable release, the newest available driver might refuse to play well. No problem— try the driver version before it, or roll back to an even older one. On AMD, you must've seen multiple versions of drivers offered already. For Nvidia, scroll down and click on Beta and Older Drivers . Don't forget to run the DDU tool before installing a different version.

3. Run Apex Legends as Administrator.

Sometimes a quick and easy fix might be all you need. Here's how to make Apex Legends run with Administrator privileges:

Find the folder Apex Legends is installed in. Right-click on r5apex.exe and select Properties . Switch over to the Compatibility tab. Put a checkmark in front of Run this program as an administrator . Optional . Put a checkmark in front of Disable fullscreen optimizations . Click on OK .

4. Repair Apex Legends.

There's a chance that an Apex Legends file wasn't downloaded, got corrupted, or was accidentally deleted. Here are two ways to run a scan to check that necessary files are present:

Steam

If you are using Steam, do this to repair Apex Legends:

Right-click on Apex Legends in the left-hand menu. Select Properties . Switch over to the Local Files tab. Click on Verify Integrity of the Game Files...

Origin.

Here's how to repair Apex Legends on Origin:

Open the Game Library . Click on Apex Legends. Click on the cogwheel (gearbox) icon. Select Repair from the list of options.

5. Turn off all overlays.

Having an overlay might be convenient, but could also be the source of constant crashes in Apex Legends. Since every program has a built-in on/off toggle, and we can't cover them all, here are some of the program names to check on your PC and disable: Discord, TeamSpeak, MSI Afterburner, RivaTuner, EVGA Precision, Aura for ASUS, ASUS GPU Tweak II, GeForce Experience, Radeon ReLive, Fraps, OBS, Voicemeeter.

Origin.

Even the necessary base app for gaming has overlay enabled by default. Here's how to disable Origin overlay:

Follow steps 1 through 3 above. Select Game Properties . Uncheck the box in front of Enable Origin In Game for Apex Legends. Click Save .

6. Limit FPS.

Setting an optimal maximum FPS limit ensures your computer isn't overtaxed and can provide stability and a crash-free experience. We recommend you set it slightly higher than your monitor refresh rate (60 Hz = 60 FPS, for example) and disable V-Sync (Method 8). Experiment with the number until you are satisfied with the performance and Apex Legends crashes disappear. Follow the same set of 4 steps above to open Game Properties , and then:

Switch over to the Advanced Launch Options tab. In the Command line arguments text field, enter: +fps_max 63 Click Save .

7. Reduce graphical settings.

A common source of constant Apex Legends crashes is graphical settings that are too high. Do this to check if you overestimated your computer and forced it to struggle in-game:

In the lobby, click the cogwheel/gearbox icon in the bottom left corner. Click on Settings . Navigate to the Video tab. First, click on Restore Defaults , then Yes .

If crashes continue to occur, go back to the same screen, and change options from:

On to Off Enabled to Disabled Medium/High to Low.

Try again, and if the game is stable, start enabling settings one by one until you reach a breaking point. When it crashes, go back one step and you have your best playable settings.

8. Disable V-Sync and enable Adaptive Resolution.

In the same Video tab, switch V-Sync to Disabled. At this point, you can experiment with the Adaptive Resolution FPS Target number. Find one that doesn't cause crashing while being smooth enough for an FPS game. The number should be identical to your monitor refresh rate or slightly above, as mentioned in method 6.

9. Move away from Full Screen.

In the Video tab, under Display Mode , switch Full Screen to Windowed or Borderless . The difference will be slight, but the non-stop crashing in Apex Legends might be gone for good.

10. Put Origin and Apex Legends on High Priority.

Some gamers report this has freed them from Apex Legends errors and crashes. Here's how to change the priority of Apex Legends in Task Manager:

Right-click on the Start orb in the bottom left corner. Select Task Manager . Switch over to the Details tab. Find r5apex.com and right-click on it. Choose Set priority > High . Repeat the process for Origin.exe .

11. Put Easy Anti Cheat on Low Priority.

Some people also recommend finding the .exe file for Easy Anti Cheat in the Details tab and setting its priority to Low . Try it with and without setting r5apex.exe and Origin.exe to High and see if it makes a difference.

12. Downclock RAM.

Every motherboard series has a different BIOS UI. Luckily, in this case, motherboards that support both AMD and Intel CPUs share an option for RAM configurations titled XMP Profile. The common problem is this. You purchase a RAM stick rated at 3200 MHz, apply the overclock, the system boots, and Apex Legends runs. This, however, doesn't always guarantee that RAM is stable at that frequency, especially when gaming. We suggest taking the RAM setting down a notch and seeing if it helps. For example, reduce it from 3200 MHz to 2933 MHz.

13. Disable Nvidia G-SYNC or AMD FreeSync.

For these options to appear, your monitor needs to support one or both features. Here's how to turn FreeSync and G-Sync off:

G-Sync.

The Set up G-Sync option is located under Display in the NVIDIA Control Panel program. Simply uncheck the box in front of Enable G-Sync .

AMD FreeSync.

Open AMD Radeon Software , and go to the Gaming tab. Click on Global Display and toggle the Radeon FreeSync option to Off.

14. Run a troubleshoot compatibility check.

Right-click on the Apex Legends icon on your Desktop or the r5apex.exe file. Select Troubleshoot compatibility , then try both Try recommended settings and Troubleshoot program .

15. Change these Nvidia GPU values.

Nvidia users claim this reduced the number of crashes in Apex Legends or eradicated them. Change these settings in the NVIDIA Control Panel under Manage 3D settings :

Ambient Occlusion to Off. Power management mode from Optimal performance to Prefer maximum performance.

16. Don't use ALT + TAB.

Seriously! Although it may sound weird, many gamers who have this problem swear by this. They noticed that as soon they used ALT + TAB to switch to another window, crashes were inevitable down the road.

17. Try the New Desktop trick.

Someone discovered this trick and people report it has worked for them. Maybe it will for you too? Here's what to do:

Open Apex Legends. Hold down the Windows key + Tab . Click on New desktop in the top left corner. Drag Apex Legends to Desktop 2 . Optional . Some players also apply methods 10 and 11 at this point. Optional 2. Other players kill that r5apex.exe process in Task Manager instead. Then, they launch a new Apex Legends window which becomes crash-free somehow.

18. Check for corrupted pagefiles.

Many players reported this to be the culprit. The only problem is – the scanning process might take a while. Here's how to run a System File Checker:

Apex Legends for Windows.

Apex Legends is a free -to-play battle royale game released by Respawn Entertainment in February 2019. In this imaginative realm, the matches are completed in the first-person shooter perspective. Access this cross-platform title on Playstation 4, Xbox One, and Windows PC through Origin. This multiplayer game has 60 total players; users join two other gamers to create a team to defeat 20 other squads of three.

Is Apex Legends pay to win?

While the BR shooter competition is free to play, people can make microtransactions for Apex Coins . The currency can be used for the in-game purchases of Apex Packs : boxes of loot . Cosmetic elements can be scored from this undertaking: badges, banners, character skins, weapons, etc. As these supplemental pieces do not have an indispensable impact, Apex Legends is not pay-to-win .

What is the point of Apex Legends?

As with other battle royale games, there is an imminent danger that encroaches on the players. Aside from enemies, competitors have to be aware of the Ring . The Ring invades in periodic waves and can cause lethal damage . The goal of Apex Legends is to thwart contact with the Ring and survive in the presence of contestants to be the victor.

This videogame is thoroughly team-focused . Implementing a hero-based system, Apex Legends offers characters to choose from that are referred to as legends : Bangalore, Bloodhound, Caustic, Crypto, Gibraltar, Lifeline, Loba, Mirage, Octane, Pathfinder, Revenant, Wattson, and Wraith.

Each of the legendary characters has a specific set of three powerful abilities: passive , tactical , and ultimate . Considering abilities, team members need to be strategic about which legends they combine together into a battle group.

The passive proficiency allows the legends' actions to always be active and not require a cooldown . Tactical capabilities have a quick recharge period, while the ultimate capacity takes the longest to regain strength.

The passive abilities' features include Gun Shield, Swift Mend, Tracker, etc. For the tactical category, legends can have the Dome of Protection, Grappling Hook, Smoke Launcher, etc. Ultimate capacities are Defensive Bombardment, Vanishing Act, Zipline Gun, etc.

After selecting the legend, navigate to the "Play" option on the upper toolbar. In the bottom-left corner, there is a box above the "Ready" icon that users should choose; game modes will be revealed: Duos , Firing Range , Play Apex , Ranked Leagues , Training , and Trios . Based on the desired experience, decide which mode to begin.

Does Apex Legends have a storyline?

The storyline begins in a drop-ship like in other battle royale games. Gamers can view the map to choose where to land on the frontier; the maps' activity levels will be shown in the bottom-right corner with the color blue indicating low commotion, yellow signaling a medium amount of action, and red equating to a high concentration of adversaries.

Within the allocated teams, there will be one jumpmaster that controls where the squad descends. Members who are not the jumpmaster have the option to disconnect from the team to do a solo plummet .

The entire team can descend the aircraft together . As the legends are flying through the air, the users can monitor their speed and altitude . Already within the first moments of the event, the Apex Legends community is honing their unique skills within the skydive session. To avoid landing on the fringes of the map, consumers may need to practice and gain experience.

There are multiple maps to play: King's Canyon, World's Edge, etc. Informational tools will be supplemented on the map that includes the hot zone , supply drop , and supply ship , which are concentrated loot areas, and the respawn beacon which is used to revive partners.

The Apex Legends basic gameplay.

Throughout the game, a compass is visible in the middle-upper screen. Once on the ground, gather weapons as quickly as possible to inhibit the possibility of contestants collecting them first. There are close- and long-range shooting items available.

Gear is provided to the legends within the game: backpack, body shield, helmet, knockdown shield, etc. Different tiers correlate to the assets that each equipment provides: Common , Rare , Epic , and Legendary . Common is identifiable as white , Rare is blue , Epic is purple , and Legendary as gold .

The helmet is protective of health against headshots from other players; helmets cannot be broken. The body and knockdown shields function similarly by absorbing damage from opponents. As there is a limit on the number of inventory items for each legend, the backpack unlocks more inventory space for the character.

To communicate with the team members, the gamers ping one another. If more ammunition is needed, locate the inventory and tap the request to

ping the team. Additionally, the community can ping locations in front of them as an aiming system.

Is PUBG better than Apex Legends?

Call of Duty, Fortnite, PlayerUnknown's Battleground, Overwatch, and Titanfall 2 are popular titles that compare to Apex Legends. PUBG is the most lifelike of the games. Fortnite and Overwatch resemble cartoons. Call of Duty and Fortnite are free to play.

While realistic, PUBG does cost money to play, along with Overwatch and the subscription-based title Titanfall 2. Respawn Entertainment developed Titanfall—the original and 2—Medal of Honor, and Star Wars Jedi, along with Apex Legends.

Crossplay shooting game.

With the imaginative yet realistic graphics in the battle royale shooting game, Apex Legends attracts a growing roster of community members. The electronic game focuses on three people within a team helping each other in defeating the opponents. To be victorious, understand each legend's unique personality and develop a balanced team.

What's new?

Apex Legends season updates bring new characters, maps, etc. On the official website in the upper toolbar within "News", game updates can be located. Scour the list of all the previous and most recent updates within this tab. Updates can be geared towards a specific device to monitor the efficiency of the revision.

Apex Legends for Windows.

Apex Legends is a battle royale game under EA Games that is free to play. It was developed by Respawn Entertainment and released on major platforms Windows, Xbox One and PlayStation 4 on February 4, 2019. The game releases a new season every quarter, and each season brings new updates in the form of Legends (playable characters), skins and cosmetic outfits and decorations, and changes to the maps. On PC, Apex Legends is downloaded on EA's digital distribution platform Origin. Due to the fast-paced nature of the battle royale genre, beginners to gaming will most likely find gameplay overwhelming, as the tutorial is relatively short and covers only the basics, assuming that the player is familiar with gaming jargon. With some practice, even new gamers will get the hang of how the game works and the playing in squads could actually be to their benefit.

A true competitor for Fortnite emerges without fanfare.

The main screen shows a default Legend which you can change in the Legends tab. There are a few that are playable, but the greyed out characters become available as you level up. The home page also has daily challenges that earn you points for actions like getting headshots with certain weapons while you are using a specific Legend. You can unlock skins, weapons, finishing moves and other cool elements. After exploring the home page, you must complete the training session, or tutorial before you can begin the main game. You start out as a Legend named Lifeline, whose Tactical Ability is being a Combat Medic. You're taught how to maneuver your character with a mouse and keyboard, sprint and slide before your character is brought out to the tutorial field to meet Pathfinder, another Legend.

Pathfinder walks you through the tutorial and shows you how to pick up items, communicate with teammates, ping ammo and enemy locations, shoot and aim at targets and other basic training tips. You learn that Lifeline's Ultimate Ability is her Lifeline Package, which has health and other defensive loot. She can distribute health to other squadmates that are near. Respawn teammates with their banners while standing near respawn beacons.

Getting started.

Start the match by launching with your squad out of a dropship. You have no weapons or items, so until you find some on the ground, you have to rely on melee attacks and stealth. The Jumpmaster chooses where on the map you'll drop. If you're assigned to be Jumpmaster, you can pass the responsibility off to another squadmate and launch solo. Once on the ground, the goal of the match is to explore the area, finding loot boxes to hopefully acquire weapons, health packs, and other useful items. Usually, a battle royale means that the goal is to be the last man standing, but the game forces you to be in squads of three. This is frustrating if your squad grabs all of the loot or don't work together as a team, leaving you scrambling to find items to defend yourself in the middle of a battle. Weapons are different colors, each representing a level of rarity and you can only hold two at a time. White is least rare, while gold is the most and highly coveted. Besides guns, throwing weapons, armor, and explosives, you can use your Tactical and Ultimate Ability, but they have to charge as you play before you're able to use them. In the Kill enemies by weapon or hand to hand combat and survive until your squad are the only players remaining. Scouring the map to find weapons and items is made even more difficult when after a few minutes of play, a barrier begins to close in around the map, squeezing everyone together and making the battle even more intense.

Where can I run this program?

Apex Legends is available to play on PC, Xbox One, and PlayStation 4. If you're going to be playing on a PC, it is highly recommended that you use a desktop or gaming laptop with a high-quality graphics card and enough space for the game, which is just under 13GB. If you're not into shelling out for a gaming setup and it's not impossible to use a regular laptop to play, but you'll have to lower your settings to hold up at 60fps in order to avoid lag or other gameplay errors.

Is there a better alternative?

A good alternative to Apex Legends would be PlayerUnknown's BattleGrounds. This game is also in the battle royale genre, and sticks to what we would normally expect - you win when you're the last player left alive. Similarly to Apex, you and your team members are dropped from an aircraft onto the map and you have to find weapons, armor, and other items to survive while the barrier closes in. The differences are that you don't have to rely as much on your group, and can pick them off as you near the end of the match if you choose. You have the option in the beginning to play solo or to choose the number of friends you play with as a part of your squad. There are no special skills, magical powers or abilities - everyone is the same, a regular human being that starts off with nothing, and can use guns or frying pans to fight.

Our take.

Apex Legend is a great game. It's polished and pure fun, and we're honestly surprised that a publisher like EA released something with so much promise as a free to play title. After playing, we can see why over 50 million people downloaded this title within the first month after launch.

Should you download it?

Yes. Even though the game is free to play, in order to get new skins you'll have to use real money. The in-game currency is Crafting Materials, which you can get in Apex Packs that are earned each time that you level up your Legend. With that said, the pros far outweigh the cons. We absolutely recommend downloading this game, and players of all skill levels should at least give it a try. The base game has a unique Legend for everyone, you can use both real weapons and magical abilities, and have a great time exploring a huge map with a ton of fascinating and creative elements.
