A file with the BDMV file extension is a Blu-ray Information file, sometimes called a Blu-ray Disc Movie Information file. They contain information about the contents of a Blu-ray disc, but they don't hold the actual multimedia files themselves.

Some common BDMV files include `index.bdmv`, `MovieObject.bdmv`, and `sound.bdmv`.

AVCHD Information (.BDM) is a similar file format but is usually seen only on hard drives. BDMV files are commonly used on optical discs.

## How to Open a BDMV File.

Most popular disc authoring programs that support Blu-ray disc burning will open BDMV files, like the free MPC-HC and VLC.

CyberLink PowerDVD, JRiver Media Center, Nero, and Macgo Mac Blu-ray Player support BDMV files as well but none of them are free to use (but they may have trial versions available).

You might also be able to use Notepad or another free text editor to open the BDMV file. Many files are text-only files meaning no matter the file extension, a text editor may be able to properly display the file's contents. Since BDMV files just hold information about the Blu-ray disc, it's possible that a text editor can open one.

If you find that an application on your PC does try to open the BDMV file but it's the wrong application or you'd rather have another installed program open BDMV files, see our guide for making that change in Windows.

## How to Convert a BDMV File.

Given that BDMV files are descriptive files only, you can't convert them to a multimedia format like MP4, MKV, etc.

However, there are some converters available that are advertised as "BDMV converters" that work by converting the video/audio contents (like the MTS/M2TS files) of the Blu-ray disc to other formats, but never the actual .BDMV files.

UniConverter is one example but it's not free. There are also free file converters like Freemake Video Converter and EncodeHD that can convert the media files from the Blu-ray disc, but they probably can't import the BDMV files or folders directly; you'd instead just choose the whole disc.

For example, Freemake Video Converter can convert a video disc to MKV, MP4, ISO, or even directly to another disc (which is useful if you have a copy of the Blu-ray disc on your computer).

## Still Can't Open the File?

If you can't get your file to open in the programs mentioned above, you might be misreading the file extension. If this happens, you'll end up trying to open a different file in a BDMV file opener, which most likely won't work.

For example, BMD (Mu Online Game Data), DMB (BYOND Game Executable), BDB (Microsoft Words Database Backup), and BDF (Binary Data) files all share common letters with the BDMV file extension but they're in other formats that aren't related to the software mentioned above.

In VLC Player, Select Media > Open Folder . Navigate to the BDMV folder and choose Play .

You will need to use a third-party application to convert BDMV to MKV. For example, you can download Leawo Blu-ray to MKV converter and select Convert or Blu-ray/DVD Ripper to enter the converting interface. Import BDMV files and then change the format to MKV Video or H.265 MKV .

Generally, there are 2 simplified approaches to play BDMV folder on Windows BDMV Player.

Option 1: Drag the whole Blu-ray first-level folder to Macgo Blu-ray Player's interface. Then you will see the navigation panel. You can click play movie option to play the movie directly, or select a chapter or title to play.

Option 2: Open Blu-ray Folder directly.

Click "Open Disc" button and click "Open Folder" in the pop-up window. Choose the BDMV folders and find one folder you want to watch, and then click "Select Folder".

Please always open / select the whole Blu-ray first-level folder, or it may cause some unwanted trouble. Most of the Blu-ray disc is protected with copyright, so is a BDMV File. This is why you can not play BDMV files by VLC Media player and it even pops up error like "This Blu-ray disc needs a library for AACs decoding, and your system does not have it." In this case, you need a professional BDMV player. In the following, we will share how to play BDMV Files by a versatile BDMV player – VideoSolo Blu-ray Player.

How to Open and Play BDMV File with BDMV Player for Windows/Mac.

(opens new window) is born for playing BDMV File, folder as well as Blu-ray disc. It can decode the protection when you add the BDMV file into the program so that you can watch the BDMV file without obstacle. As a BDMV player, VideoSolo performs well in delivering cinema-like experience for its master-quality and audio effect. It supports audio decoding systems like DTS and Dolby digital, which you will have better listening experience. It can be used for common video playback.

In the following, I will take Windows version as an example to show how to open and play BDMV files without limitation in 3 steps.

If you want to open or play BDMV folders on your Windows or Mac, you need to keep this in your mind: BDMV folder is not the Blu-ray first-level directory. Therefore, if you want play BDMV folder, you need to select the Blu-ray folder as a whole, instead of any streaming file.

Step 1. Download and Install BDMV Player.

Click the download button above to download BDMV player on your computer. After installation, double click to launch it.

## Step 2. Add BDMV File.

Press on "Open Disc" on the main interface and then it will pop up a window where you can select BDMV file you want to play back. After selection, click "OK".

## Step 3. Play BDMV Files on Computer.

Once finish loading the BDMV files, it will appear the playback menu on bottom left, which includes Play Movie, Chapter, Audio, Subtitle and Other Titles. You can choose "Play Movie" to directly play the Blu-ray movie. Or you can adjust chapter, audio track, subtitle first to meet your watching habits.

In the bottom, you can click "Playlist" to check the video you have ever played back. You can click the camera icon the snapshot the picture you want.

## More Resources - What Is A BDMV File.

Files that contain the .bdmv file extension are most commonly associated with Blu-ray movie information files. These files describe the contents of an associated Blu-ray movie disc and can include information about the names of the movie files and the directory location of the movie, the movie objects, and the movie file's audio data. (Source: file.org)

Various BDMV files store different information:

index.bdmv: describes the file contents in the BDMV directory; found in the BDMV and BDMV/BACKUP directories.

MovieObject.bdmv: describes one or more movie objects; located in the BDMV and BDMV/BACKUP directories.

sound.bdmv: optional file that relates one or more sounds associated with HDMV; Interactive Graphic streams applications; located in the BDMV/AUXDATA directory.

You might find BDMV files from:

HD Camcorders' AVCHD folders (BDMV and CERTIFICATE) with M2TS extension files. For Sony HDR-SR11 camcorder, the AVCHD files will bear the MTS extension. Blu-ray disc with BDMV folder and files with BDMV extension. Ripped Blu-ray DVD movies, the folder structure of which is all contained in a BDMV folder structure with M2TS extension files. Blu-ray movie with BDMV & CERTIFICATE folder, one subfolder of the BDMV folder is the stream folder and in this folder, there is an MTS extension file.
