The Sims 4 is now available on PlayStation 4 as a free PS Plus title for February. This means you can play the role of a mischievous god for the price of nada if you own a PlayStation Plus subscription. For those of you who crave the luxurious life of a celebrity without having to go through all the struggles sobbed about in Oscar-bait biopics, in this article you'll discover a bunch of money cheats so you can get as much cash as you want straightaway.

It's appropriate that The Sims 4 is one of the free PS Plus titles this February as this month marks the series' 20th anniversary. To celebrate us all getting old, grey and closer to Death's doorstep, EA has returned the hot tub. In addition to the series becoming 20-years old, EA has also released the Tiny Living Stuff Pack on both PS4 and Xbox One after previously launching on PC only.

If PS Plus is the reason you're returning to the series for the first time in many years, then below you'll find out how to use cheats and money hacks on PS4.

How to use cheats for The Sims 4 on PS4.

You need to pull up the cheat box to use cheats for The Sims 4 on PS4.

However, before you can use any cheat you want, you must first enable hacks by typing in testingcheats on .

In order to pull up the cheat box, all you need to do is press all four shoulder buttons at the same time. These buttons are L1, L2, R1 and R2.

Before you go making life a breeze for your Sims, you should first know that enabling and using cheats will prevent you from earning trophies with your household.

Also, if you wish to disable cheats in order to make the game more challenging and – to be honest – more fun, all you need to do is enter testingcheats off .

There are three money cheats you can use for The Sims 4 on PS4.

The cheats kaching or rosebud both add 1,000 simoleon's to your household's balance, whereas motherlode adds a whopping 50,000.

If you want to be swimming in cash relatively fast, then you can just keep exploiting the motherlode cheat repeatedly.

However, if you want a precise amount of dough your doorstep asap, you can just enter money [insert number here without brackets] .

For those who want to make the lives of their Sims even easier, you can also make all the houses in a neighbourhood free by entering the cheat code freerealestate on . You can then turn disable it afterwards with freerealestate off .

And, as if all of the above wasn't enough, you can also stop your Sims from having to endure the hardships of reality that come with paying bills.

The cheat household autopay\_bills true will disable bills for your household, whereas the same cheat with false instead of true will re-enable them.

You Can Get 'The Sims 4' For Free On PC Right Now, But Here's A Warning.

Here's my first piece of advice: go get The Sims 4 for free, right now. There's no franchise quite like The Sims in the entire video game industry, and I've spent countless hours obsessively building restaurants in bars in The Sims 4 , carefully placing clutter in homes to give it that "lived-in" feeling, obsessing over rock placement to try and make a landscape that looks real. It's one of my favorite games.

To get it you'll need EA's Origin client, but you need that for any EA games. Just head here and grab it: it's only available until May 28, but if you get it now, it's yours forever.

What you'll get is a marvelously open-ended experience that can be more or less anything you want it to be. You might play it a little like an RPG, raising your skills, getting promoted in your career and raising enough funds to build your dream house. You might use cheats and build your dream house right away: or your dream bar, gym, museum or whatever. You might design some sort of twisted world where you imprison family members in the basement to slave away at work-from-home jobs to furnish your increasingly lavish lifestyle. Maybe you just want to get something going with an alien! That's The Sims: it has structure, but you get out of it what you put into it.

Here's what I'll say, however. If you're anything like me--it has its plusses and minuses--this game will not be free for very long. If you're anything like me, you'll wind up spending money on the thing before you even turn it on. I mean, don't you want a bowling alley in your house? You can do it with the bowling stuff pack, which also comes with a bunch of charming mid-century style decor. Or maybe you want a hamster? Of course you want a hamster, and that will require the complete Pets pack. Or how about Tudor-style exteriors and a lovely dark wood dining room table? And are you really going to pass up the glass ceilings available with the Seasons expansions? None of this stuff is cheap. The Sims 4 is stacked with game packs, expansions and stuff packs from years of release, and it's all great. Loading up will cost some money, however.

Sure, you could just happily play the base game and be a normal, non-compulsive person. But there's just so much to be had in the ever-expanding world of bonus items. Frankly, it wouldn't be the worst decision to just make the base game permanently free-to-play and to make the money back both on expansions and permanent Sims converts.

The Sims 4 on Steam purchases won't transfer over from Origin, but its DLC will.

The Sims 4 is now on Steam, and you can bring the content you already own on Origin with you - with one important caveat.

If you buy The Sims 4 on Steam, you'll automatically get access to all the other Sims 4 stuff you already had: that includes game saves, DLC packs, in-game currency, and virtual currency. Note that it all hinges on you buying The Sims 4 on Steam; your purchase of the game itself cannot carry over from Origin to Steam. An EA representative confirmed this detail for us when we asked about transferring content from one service to the other.

The Sims 4 itself is a pretty small purchase compared to the vast quantities of expansions and stuff packs that dedicated Sims fans have assembled by now. It's also currently on sale for 50% off on Steam until July 9, bringing the price down to \$19.99.

EA also confirmed that EA Access is headed to Steam in August. The subscription service includes free access to The Sims 4 and some of its DLC as well, so if you aren't already fully invested in The Sims 4 ecosystem you may want to wait to give that a shot.

Sims 4: Can You Get Mods on Xbox One & PS4? Answered.

The Sims 4 is truly at home on PC, but that hasn't stopped EA and Maxis from bringing the popular life-sim game to PS4 and Xbox One. Of course, some players may be wondering if it's possible to get Sims 4 mods on PS4 and Xbox One. Here's what you need to know.

Sims 4 Mods on PS4? What You Need to Know.

Unfortunately, you cannot get Sims 4 mods on PS4. This is sadly one of the features that didn't make the cut when the game was ported to console. This news was shared by Michael Duke, a Senior Producer on the game, who replied to a tweet regarding mod support for The Sims 4 on PS4 back in 2017.

No mods but we will support both the x and pro hardware. — Michael Duke (@SimGuruDuke) August 30, 2017.

At the same time, Duke also confirmed that Custom Content (CC) will also not be supported either. For those not aware, Custom Content are essentially mods that use entirely third-party, user-created assets, rather than anything that may be tweaked or adjusted in-game like visual or UI mods.

Can You Get Sims 4 Mods on Xbox One?

Sadly, again, the answer is a resounding no. You cannot get Sims 4 mods on Xbox One. In fact, both mods and custom content are not supported on the Xbox One, just like the PS4. While this may come as disappointing news to some fans, mod support on consoles for games in general tends to be rare.

Only Bethesda has managed to implement mod support for Skyrim Special Edition and Fallout 4 this generation, and even then it came with limitations on the PS4 hardware due to disagreements with Sony.
