How to download Windows 10 ISO for free.

Need to download the Windows 10 installation disc image (.ISO) because you want to install it on your brand new PC using a USB stick or DVD? Or simply reinstall it by completely reformatting your computer? It's all very simple and 100% free – whether or not you have a Windows 10 license.

There are several reasons why it is necessary at one time or another to download the ISO of Windows 10 . If you have assembled your PC yourself, for example. Or if your PC has completely crashed and even the recovery tool doesn't want to know. Or maybe you want to create a second bootable partition, on which another version of Windows 10 will boot? A very handy manipulation to test the operating system pre-versions, which are available through Windows Update.

The good news is that Microsoft makes Windows 10 .ISO files available for free . This type of file will allow you to install the system by booting directly from BIOS / UEFI, without having installed anything first. Or, if you already have an operating system installed, it will allow you to install Windows 10 on a second partition or hard drive, so that the OS brings up a dual-boot menu.

In this tutorial, we are going to show you how to download the Windows 10 .ISO disk image in order to burn it or create a bootable volume with your preferred method. The easiest way is to use the tool Media Creation Tool . An option allows you to generate an ISO file that can be mounted later on a USB key or burn to a DVD.

Create an ISO of Windows 10 with the Media Creation Tool.

Just go to this address on Microsoft's site. Click the second download button on the page (Download the tool now). The download of the Media Creation Tool will start automatically. Launch the tool (no installation required) and accept the terms. Then choose the option Create installation media.

How to download Windows 10 ISO from another OS.

The Media Creation Tool is not available for systems other than Windows. If you're on Linux or macOS, the process is even easier. You will be able to download the ISO file directly without going through a wizard. To do this :

Go to the Windows 10 download page at the same address and you will be redirected to a page relevant to your system. First select an edition of Windows 10 and click on to confirm

There you go, it's that simple. You now have a Windows 10 ISO file that you can mount to a USB drive or burn to DVD as desired. Note that the file corresponding to the latest version weighs more than 5 GB.

Download a Windows 10 .ISO file without going through the Microsoft site.

There is another way to recover a Windows 10 .ISO image without going to Microsoft's site: a small script that takes care of doing everything for you . This script is called Universal MCT Wrapper , and it offers much more than the Microsoft site. Without getting too deep into the lawlessness, since the .ISO images downloaded by the script come from Microsoft's servers. The files are healthy and their download perfectly legitimate .

ISO file, also called ISO image, is an archive file that holds the data of an entire CD or DVD, which must be extracted with the help of an ISO mounting software. The entire content of a disk can be very easily stored in the form of an ISO file. In order to use the data, you will need to build the ISO file and access it into your system. The file is of no good unless the content inside is extracted and build upon using the right product.

Microsoft Windows allows users to carry out different tasks very easily without having to worry about getting engaged in extensive methods. In Windows 8, 8.1 and 10 computers, the ISO mounting feature is built in the system. Included with so many important files, the ISO files should be kept safely with backups. In case the worst situation appears and all the files are lost, you should rescue the ISO files with file recovery software as soon as possible.

Top 13 Best Software that Can Be Used to Mount ISO Files.

The following applications come with different features and allow you to carry out different functions easily in Windows 7. Even when you are using a Windows 8 or 10 computer, they will offer some advanced functions, or serve as an alternative when the system feature fails to work.

1. Microsoft Virtual CD-ROM Control Panel

Microsoft Virtual CD-ROM Control Panel was released in 2013 which was made available for Windows XP, Windows 7, and Windows Vista so that users can mount the ISO disk image and use them as a virtual CD drive. The application can be really useful for burning disk, reading and also recover the backup files as well.

Since Windows 8 and higher versions support ISO files natively, this ISO mounting software needs to be used only in Windows 7 and earlier OSs. It does not have too many advanced features to offer to the users, but it does provide reliable service of mounting the ISO files as virtual CD or DVD.

2. DAEMON Tools Lite.

DAEMON Tools is one of the most popular software that people use to mount their ISO files. For many years this tool has been used to mount and restore millions of .iso files by thousands of customers.

This ISO mounting software is free for home and non-commercial users, but it also provides advanced features, which can be purchased separately. Interestingly, Daemon tools supports Windows 7/8/8.1/10.

3. Power ISO.

When it comes to ISO mounting, Power ISO is the first choice for many users. The versatile nature and brilliant features of the application clearly make it one of the best ISO mounters. With the assist of Power ISO, you can mount and burn files of almost every format – BIN, ISO, NRG, CDI, and DAA.

A very useful feature of this file when your system is running on Windows 7 is the aptitude to create USB bootable flash drives. The versatility of the application is revealed when it comes to knowing that apart from mounting ISO files it can also very easily rip MP3, APE, WMA, BIN, or FLAC files.

4. WinCDEmu.

WinCDEmu is an open-source ISO mounting software that can be integrated into the Windows Explorer once installed, so you will be able to utilize this app from right-click menu. It has simple functionality, and you can mount ISO files with a simple click.

Not only ISO files but also CUE, CCD, NRG, MDS/MDF, and the IMG images are supported by this well-off application. While using this application, you'd also get the ability to create as many virtual drives as you want. Even though it does not provide as many features like Power ISO or Daemon Tools, it is the best solution when you have basic needs on your computer.

5. Virtual CloneDrive.

Virtual CloneDrive has made it to our list of top 13 best software to create virtual drives and mount ISO images. This software comes for free for almost all Windows operating systems, and you can download it from the official website.

You can easily mount ISO files and put them on the virtual drives. The only drawback of this application is that you cannot create unlimited virtual drives but only eight. However, if 8 virtual drives will do your task, then it can be one of the best mounting applications for Windows which is easy to use and is not going to cost you any money.

6. ISODisk.

ISODisk is a freeware which you can use to create virtual CD/DVD drive up to 20 drives. You need to mount an ISO disk image which you want to burn. The software will automatically access the files available on the ISO disk and burn it to CD or DVD. It works in the opposite direction as well. You can create an ISO image file from a CD or DVD ROM.

Features of ISODisk:

There is no requirement of any virtual drive software to use ISODisk. It enables the user to mount ISO image files to CD or DVD. It enables the user to create ISO files from CD or DVD-ROM. It allows the user to mount an ISO image for on LAN.

Yes. Upgrading from Windows 7 SP1 or Windows 8.1 Update to Windows 10 in the first year of Windows 10 release will grant you the OS for free for the supported lifetime of the device.

Download the Win10 iso here: <http://www.bleepingcomputer.com/forums/t/584436/download-windows-10-disc-image-iso-file/> . That site has the link Aura just posted, but also a live Youtube tutorial of the download, which might prove helpful to watch. You can download as usb or DVD iso. Suggest you do both, in case one of the two media, dies.

Once you run the download tool, be sure you do NOT select 'Upgrade this PC', but rather 'download for another PC', or you cannot get the iso separately. To get the 64-bit download, you have to be on a 64-bit machine. You can get more than one version also , but no version will activate without the product key you already have in your OEM Win7 (which should be at the bottom or back or in the battery compartment of your computer), or on your 8.1 laptop. (In the battery compartment, usually. Very inconvenient.) You will have to type in the key, cannot paste it. So write it down and keep it safe. In your case, TWO keys, since you have TWO systems eligible for one each, Win10.

The 'version' has to match what you have. If you have Win7 starter/Home, then you can only get Win10 home for that machine. If you have Win7 Pro, then you can only get Pro. If your Win7 is 32-bit, then the installer will only install 32-bit; if you have 64-bit, then the installer will only install 64-bit. For your 8.1 machine, same idea: replace '7' with '8.1' for your 8.1 machine in the prior sentences of this paragraph.

That will serve for your reinstaller. If you didn't already reserve for your Win7 copy, you can use it for installing Win10 to your Win7 machine too, but see here for getting ready, first.

Since you already reserved your copy for Win 8.1, the download will notify you when it's done. Might be any day up to some months away.

As for how long free, it's free. If you wait to install it after July 29 2016, it won't be free anymore. So if you install it prior, it stays free, though unlike others I'm not sure the updates will stay free; there's no promise of them being free, in the licensing agreement. The original Win10, yes

stays free if you install it in time.
