Convert a notebook to a different format.

If you're using an older version of OneNote, you may be prompted to upgrade to the latest version. It's a good idea to upgrade because you'll have access to all the latest features, including:

Notebook Recycle Bin.

Manually converting notebooks between file formats.

OneNote 2016 has a conversion tool so you can upgrade a legacy notebook to the current format. OneNote 2010, 2013, and 2016 use the same file format so you don't need to convert files between these versions. You can use them interchangeably.

Tip: If you're not sure which version of OneNote you're using, look at the title bar of your notebook. If the words [Compatibility Mode] are in the title, you're working in an older notebook format.

Choose File > Info.

Next to the notebook you want to convert, choose Settings, and then choose Properties.

In the Notebook Properties dialog box, look at the Default Format to see what format the current notebook is saved in.

To upgrade a OneNote 2007 notebook to the newer 2010-2016 format, click Convert to 2010-2016.

Note: The 2010-2016 file format can't be used by OneNote 2007. If you already upgraded a notebook to the 2010-2016 file format you won't be able to migrate it back again.

Notebooks on OneDrive use the latest OneNote file format. Users without OneNote 2010 or later can use the free web version or download a free version of OneNote from OneNote to access the notebook.

Manually converting notebooks between file formats.

Converting a file is useful if you need to share a OneNote 2013 notebook with people who still use OneNote 2007, or when you've finished sharing a OneNote 2007 notebook and you want to use all the OneNote 2013 features again.

OneNote 2013 has a conversion tool so you can upgrade a legacy notebook format to the current format. OneNote 2010 and 2013 use the same file format so you don't need to convert files between these versions. You can use them interchangeably.

Tip: If you're not sure which version of OneNote you're using, look at the title bar of your notebook. If the words [Compatibility Mode] are in the title, you're working in an older notebook format.

Click File > Info.

Click Settings next to the notebook you want to convert, and then click Properties .

In the Notebook Properties dialog box, look at the Default Format to see what format the current notebook is saved in, and then do one of the following:

To convert a OneNote 2007 notebook to the newer 2010-2013 format, click Convert to 2010 -2013.

To convert a OneNote 2013 notebook to the older 2007 format, click Convert to 2007 .

Note: The 2010-2013 file format can't be used by OneNote 2007. If you already upgraded a notebook to the 2010-2013 file format and you need to revert to the older 2007 format, simply follow the previous steps to convert the notebook back again. Consider making a separate backup copy of your 2013 notebook before converting it to the older 2007 format.

Notebooks on OneDrive use the latest OneNote file format. Users without OneNote 2010 or later can use the free web version or download a free version of OneNote from OneNote to access the notebook.

Convert a presentation from a previous PowerPoint version to PowerPoint 2013 or later.

While you can view and work with presentations created in older versions of PowerPoint, you might get improved performance and additional features if you convert those presentations to the latest PowerPoint (.pptx) file format.

Click the File tab.

On the Info tab, click Convert.

After conversion, you are prompted to save the converted presentation. If the original presentation is a PowerPoint 97-2003 (.ppt) presentation, that original is preserved alongside the new file. If the original is a PowerPoint 2007 or PowerPoint 2010 presentation (.pptx), the file is replaced if you give the converted presentation the same file name and extension.

What if the Convert command doesn't appear?

If the Convert command doesn't appear, the presentation content is up-to-date, and converting is not required. The Convert command appears only if one of the following is true about the presentation:

It was created or saved in the .ppt file format from Office PowerPoint 2003 or earlier.

It contains one or more diagrams or charts created in PowerPoint 2007 or earlier. This doesn't includeSmartArt graphic.

It contains media objects, such as audio or video clips, created or inserted using PowerPoint 2007.

Convert Data From an Earlier Version of Quicken (When to Use an Intermediate Version)

When you open your Quicken data file in a new version of Quicken, your data file is updated to work with the newer program's architecture. We call this converting your data. You can also "convert" your data from Quicken for Windows to Quicken for Mac (or vice versa).

Note: The conversion process provided here applies only to U.S. versions of Quicken.

Quicken for Windows.

Before you begin: The option to convert files from previous versions of Quicken is available, however, if you convert from any Quicken for Windows version older than Quicken 2010, you may experience some data file issues. Unfortunately, if you choose to do this, we will be unable to assist you with any issues you encounter during the conversion process. We can only assist with conversions from 2010 or later versions of Quicken.

Also note that you do not need to uninstall Quicken before going through this process. Installing a new version of Quicken automatically uninstalls the older version.

If you are converting a data file from Quicken 2010 or later.

You do not need to follow the steps in this article. An intermediate version of Quicken is not necessary. Simply install your new version of Quicken and open your data file.

If you are converting from Quicken 2004 through 2009.

You will need to download Quicken 2013 and use it to open and convert your Quicken 2004 - 2009 file.

Do not install your new version until you complete these steps:

Step 1: Back up and install Quicken 2013.

Back up your data file in Quicken. Close Quicken. Download Quicken 2013 for Windows. Please note that although the Quicken 2013 provided here is Deluxe, it can also convert files from higher versions of Quicken. Select Save File , then browse to your desktop and save it there. From your desktop, double-click the newly downloaded file QW2013DLX.exe . Follow the on-screen instructions to install and convert your existing data file.

Step 2: Install the current version of Quicken.

Back up your data file in Quicken 2013. Close Quicken. Install your current version of Quicken for Windows.

Converting a data file from Quicken 98 - 2003.

This will require converting the file to Quicken 2004 first.

Quicken 2004 has been tested and will install and run on Windows 7, 8, and 8.1 operating systems (32- or 64-bit for Quicken 2004) through the conversion process . It has not been tested with Windows 10.

Do not install your new version until you complete these steps:

Step 1: Back up and install Quicken 2004.

If you're using Quicken 98 - 2003, make sure your data file is current, then back up your file. Close Quicken. Download Quicken 2004 for Windows. Select Save File, then browse to your desktop and save it there. From your desktop, double-click the newly downloaded file QW04DLX.exe. Follow the on-screen instructions to install and convert your existing data file.

Step 2: Back up and install Quicken 2013.

Backup your data file in Quicken 2004. Close Quicken. Download Quicken 2013 for Windows. Please note that although the Quicken 2013 provided here is Deluxe, it can also convert files from higher versions of Quicken. Select Save File, then browse to your desktop and save it there. From your desktop, double-click the newly downloaded file QW2013DLX.exe. Follow the on-screen instructions to install and convert your

existing data file. This is the last intermediate step before converting to the version of Quicken you'll end up using.

Step 3: Install the current version of Quicken.

Back up your data file in Quicken 2013. Close Quicken. Install your current version of Quicken for Windows.

Converting a data file from versions of Quicken older than 1998.

It is no longer possible to convert from versions of Quicken older than Quicken 1998; we recommend that you open a new data file in the latest version of Quicken, for stability.

After the process is complete, verify the information is correct. If you find errors or issues with your data, it is best to manually correct them.

Quicken for Mac.

Can I convert from an earlier version of Quicken for Mac to the Subscription Release?

Can I convert from a version of Quicken for Mac older than 2007?

Quicken for Mac products older than 2007 are not supported for conversion; however, if you have a data file from an older version of Quicken for Mac, you can attempt to update to the latest Mac version.

Install the latest version of Quicken for Mac Select the Start from a Quicken Mac 2007 file option, even if your file is from a version that's older than 2007. See the "Start from an existing Quicken 2007 file" section in this FAQ for information about converting to a new version of Quicken for Mac.

Please note that this conversion may not be successful, given the age of your data file; we recommend that you open a new data file in the latest version of Quicken, for stability.
