How To Watch PSVR Porn In 3D With PlayStation VR – Free real 3D VR porn has arrived at last on PlayStation VR, and it's easy to set-up – hurrah!. Having already explained how to watch PSVR porn in 360-degrees in mono, and having outlined plans from the likes of adult movie makers VRPorn, you can now watch 3D VR porn directly through the PS4 and the PSVR headset. Better yet, as the PS5 supports PSVR, you'll be able to get PSVR driven PS5 porn right now too. Let's have no doubt about that – especially when you think what improvements in fidelity that the PS5 spec will bring in this regard.

So far, PSVR users have been restricted to watching 2D 360 content, but we've now tested this out and it works a treat- so here's a step-by-step guide on how to watch adult movie video content and real 3D VR porn on PlayStation VR.

Watch Free PSVR Porn.

Whether it's 3D Hentai, 3D anime, or something else, you can watch tons of VR porn videos. Virtual reality porn offers a new way to watch your favorite movies. So watch porn on PlayStation and enjoy the best 360-degree videos.

Further Reading:

1. Make sure that your PS Media Player is updated to at least version 2.50 – this was the release which supported 360 degree videos; you can check your Media Player version by pressing the options button on the DualShock 4, whilst highlighting the app, and then scroll down to 'Version History' to find out.
2. Insert a PS4 compatible Flash USB drive into your PC (for reference we used the WD Elements Portable Hard Drive 1 TB. You're now going to find the VR adult films and put them onto your drive.
3. Create a folder named VIDEO on your Flash USB thumb drive (make sure that it has been formatted to FAT32 or ExFAT).
4. Search online for 3D VR porn films. You can do this by using a search engine and typing in something like 3D video porn or sbs videos porn. Download your mp4 porn video. Note: Many sites will require a sign-up and some may require you to take out a subscription or pay-per-movie, or you may be able to find free videos. VRPorn.com is a great place to start.
5. Download the PSVR porn video onto your USB drive putting it into the VIDEO folder.
6. Remove the USB flash drive from your PC or laptop and put it into the USB port on your PS4.
7. Open up the PlayStation Media Player app while wearing your PlayStation VR headset (make sure it's turned on!)
8. Navigate to the Library option, and you should now see your downloaded videos under 'VIDEO'
9. Click on play and you should now be watching 3D VR porn. Don't worry if when you load the file for the first time that it is in 2D, simply press the Options button again to launch the video in 3D and away you go.
10. Close the curtains and lock the cat in the kitchen. Actually, do that before you put the headset on! Oh and tissues might be a plan too.

The complete guide on watching Playstation VR 3D movies.

It was somehow mandatory for Sony to join the virtual reality game, as the Japanese manufacturer had all the resources required to develop a high-end platform. And, as you probably know, they did it and it was a success.

But hey, they did more than just create a virtual reality gaming device, since it also has a few extra goodies packed. Yes, you guessed it, you can watch PlayStation VR 3D movies using the headset and the experience is absolutely mental!

Before this, though, make sure you check out some of the upcoming PSVR games as well, ok? Some of them look ridiculously good!

If you had no idea that your PSVR is able to do this, then you're in the right place. Here you can find out how to set up the headset in order to enjoy movies, in just a few easy moves. And a few cool recommendations await you as well. Excited? Thought so. Let's see how it's done...

Putting the cinematic mode at work.

Besides all its gaming features, the PlayStation VR has a special cinematic feature. You can use it to play non-VR PS4 games, browse the internet in 2D, and watch VR 3D videos.

The coolest part about the latter is that you get an upgraded screen size, way larger than any standard TV set. Basically, it's like an IMAX cinema theater, but with the ideal display size and full isolation. You can feel like in a cinema by just wearing a VR headset, let that sink in for a while. But first, you need to make a couple of adjustments, for the best viewing style.

How to set up PSVR Cinematic Mode.

The mode is very easy to set up, since everything you need to do is turn on the console, plug in the headset and you will see the PS4 menu through the visor. Still, you should know that a couple of tweaks are mandatory, as the quality of the movies will not be the best all the time.

Going a bit into technical details, the Cinematic Mode allows you to watch virtual reality movies on three different screen sizes. We're talking about 117-inch (Small), 163-inch (Medium), and 226-inch (Large).

You can pick one of these by going to Settings > Devices > PlayStation VR > Cinematic Mode.

I know, 226-inch is definitely tempting. But in this case, bigger is not necessarily better. The larger the screen size, the worse the quality of the image. Don't expect Blu-Ray quality at this size, so our recommendation is to opt for 163-inch, in order to get a decent image.

What kind of virtual reality content can you watch on PSVR?

Sony issued several updates for the console's Media Player app ever since the release, meaning that you can enjoy various types of content using the PSVR. Specifically, VR movies in formats like MKV, AVI, MP4, MPEG2 PS, MPEG2 TS, AVCHD, JPEG, BMP, and PNG files can be viewed using the console's software.

Initially, the headset wasn't able to play 3D Blu-Rays, which was considered a big downside, but the manufacturer took care of this. With the PlayStation 4.50 patch, a couple of significant changes were introduced, including an update to the Cinematic Mode, which now allows you to watch 3D Blu-Rays just using the headset.

It's also worth noting that the update also brought a 120Hz refresh rate for the Small and Medium screen sizes, resulting in smoother images. This means that you can watch PlayStation VR 3D videos for a longer period, without feeling dizzy. Seriously, a lot of people are affected by this!

Unfortunately, in order to enjoy such content, you need to use a USB stick or store it on a local media server. Unfortunately, storing directly on the PS4 is not available. But Sony, if you're reading this, please have mercy of some mere mortals and think about doing something about this in the nearest future.

On the other side, let's not forget about services like Hulu or Vriideo. These have dedicated apps, allowing PSVR users to check out curated PlayStation VR movies.

Which are some PlayStation VR 3D movies worth checking out?

Since you can watch any 3D movie available on Blu-Ray, it's obvious that the selection is ridiculously high. Nevertheless, this doesn't mean that any movie is worth your time, so I decided to help you a bit on this one.

After going through a few lists, I was able to decide upon a few titles which are actually a pleasure to watch using a PSVR headset. And it doesn't matter if you already saw them on your TV, because the experience is completely different.

Avatar.

I know, it was released a century ago, but it was one of the first major 3D movies, proving critics that this format is here to stay. Bonus points for the stereoscopic design, which is thoroughly nuanced, so your eyes won't hurt after watching it for a longer period.

A Very 3D Harold and Kumar Christmas.

Another movie released a few years before writing this article, but still excellent to watch using a PSVR headset. Oh, and it's a vulgar picture, loaded with inappropriate jokes. Just thought you should know this.

Tron: Legacy.

Everybody knows that it's not as good as the original, but there's no doubt that this movie is an example of state-of-the-art 3D effects. Even though you're not a fan of the neon-lit world, enjoying it in virtual reality is an amazing experience.

How to Convert Video to Sony PlayStation VR.

If you also purchased Sony PlayStation VR and have no idea how to play videos with it, you will find the fast and handy solution in the tutorial below. However, maybe you should learn something about the Sony PlayStation VR compatible formats beforehand.

PlayStation VR Compatible Video Formats:

The video formats PlayStation VR supports are limited due to the immature VR technology. For now, you can only play 3D MP4 with PlayStation VR. If you want to convert videos to Sony PlayStation VR, you can convert them into 3D MP4. You can check out the tutorial to convert videos to Sony PlayStation VR with best quality and fastest speed.

Video Converter Ultimate: Your Premier MOV Video Converter.

Video Converter Ultimate is designed for multimedia format conversion, you can easily convert MOV files to WMV with this program!

Part 1. How to Convert Videos to Sony PlayStation VR.

You can free download Video Converter Ultimate and install it. After the setup is over, you can initiate the software then click "Add Files" on the main interface to open file browser to select video files you desire to convert.

You can now click the "Output Format" bar→"Format"→"3D" to select 3D MP4/3D MKV as the output format. Alternative, you can choose the output format in accordance with your device. Sony PlayStation VR is not on the list yet, but it is coming on the list very soon.

You can click the "Edit" button at the end of the video. Then a window will pop up for you to cut, trim the video. Besides, you can also add subtitles or filter to the video. Moreover, if you have multiple videos and you want merge them into one, you can check the option "Merge all videos into one file" on the main interface.

Once you make sure all settings are done properly, then you can start the conversion by clicking the button "Convert". The Conversion will only take a few minutes so you can take a rest. After the conversion is complete, you can open the output file to transfer the converted video into your Sony PlayStation VR for free playback.

Part 2. How to Watch VR Content on PlayStation VR.

After you have finished converting the video to 3D MP4, you still have a few steps to go if you want to enjoy VR video on your PlayStation VR. Follow the steps below to upload the video to your PlayStation VR for free playback.

1. Upload the converted 3D MP4 videos in a separate folder onto a USB drive. Your video files MUST be in a folder in order for PS4 system to recognize.
2. Insert the USB drive containing the converted VR videos into your PS4.
3. Launch the Media Player App.
4. Select VR Mode in Option (PS4 restart may be necessary).
5. Put on the headset and enjoy!

As you can see above, it only takes you a few minutes and little effort to convert videos to Sony PlayStation VR with the help of Video Converter Ultimate. PS4 porn shock as new free VR app lets randy gamers watch 'virtual reality' 18+ clips on their consoles.

HORNY gamers have a new way to watch virtual reality porn through their PlayStation 4 consoles – even though it's banned by Sony.

Smut app WatchVR lets users stream XXX videos from dirty sites to get around Sony's rules on adult content.

The app doesn't offer content itself, instead acting as a middleman for sites offering virtual reality (VR) content, reports SexTechGuide.

Virtual reality involves donning a pricey headset to simulate a virtual environment.

The technology is primarily designed for gaming but VR pornography has exploded in popularity in recent years.

Saucy video recorded from a camera on an adult star's head is beamed directly into your eyes via a VR headset.

Users of the PS4 WatchVR app will need to be a subscriber to a compatible VR porn site.

They then simply need to type the URL of the video they want to watch into the WatchVR app to stream it.

"Until now, people wanting to watch VR porn had to either sideload it, or pay for one of the alternative apps that allow you to stream via a URL," SexTechGuide said.

"WatchVR gets around that limitation, by offering a free way of streaming VR porn directly without subjecting you to ads."

Virtual Reality v.s. Augmented Reality – what's the difference?

Here's what you need to know.

Virtual reality involves using a headset to simulate a virtual world In a VR world, everything you see will be computer-generated Popular VR headsets include the HTC Vive and Facebook's Oculus Rift Augmented reality lets you see the real world, but "augments" (or adds on) computer-generated elements This means you'll be able to see computer images overlaid onto your real-world view For instance, you could wear glasses that overlay directions onto the road in front of you Popular AR headsets include Microsoft's HoloLens and the Google Glass spectacles.

10 best Google Cardboard games!

[aa_editors_tip]Google Cardboard is a very old platform and based on our research, it doesn't seem as though we'll see any new releases that push the platform forward and the interest in Google Cardboard games has waned very considerably. Because of that, this update is our final update for Google Cardboard games. We hope you enjoy the final list! We recommend checking out our best VR games list for some more modern stuff.[/aa_editors_tip]

Flats.

Price: Free / \$1.67.

Flats is definitely one of the most colorful VR games out there. It's a FPS game that lets you play both single player and multiplayer. You wander around a map and try to kill people. Your bullets also bounce off of stuff and it just looks cool to watch. You'll need a controller of some sort to play. There is also Android TV support if you want to go cross-platform. You can also cloud save so you can switch devices if needed. It's exceptionally fun to play and relatively inexpensive to pick up.

Minos Starfighter VR.

Price: Free.

Minos Starfighter VR was one of the first really decent VR games for Google Cardboard. It also used to be called End Space VR for those who may remember that one. It's a space shooter that puts you in the cockpit as you take on various bad guys in outer space fights. The game essentially lasts forever and you'll be pitted up against stronger waves of enemies as you progress. You'll also have access to ship upgrades, scoreboards, hardware controller support, and some of the best graphics of any of the VR games out there. It's relatively inexpensive and contains no in-app purchases.

Hardcode.

Price: Free / \$2.49.

Hardcode was one of the first good VR games out there and it's still one of the better shooters available. It features a third person perspective and the camera is controlled by the player's head movements. You can play single player missions or online multiplayer and this is one of the few VR games that feature an online multiplayer mode. The only caveat is that the game requires a game pad and you won't be able to play without one. It's free to download and the most expensive in-app purchase is a paltry \$2.49.

InMind VR and InCell VR.

Price: Free.

InMind VR is one of the most popular VR games to date. It's an arcade shooter where you traverse the neural pathways of the brain looking for physical abnormalities. Once you find them, you neutralize them to make the brain healthy again. It uses runner mechanics and you'll be on a predetermined path for the entire game. You'll also have the option to play with or without a VR headset if you want to and the game doesn't require a game pad to play. It's also completely free with no in-app purchases. The developer has a second game called InCell VR that is just as good as this one.

Trinus.

Price: Free / \$9.99.

TrinusVR isn't a VR game on the face of it, but it does let you play VR games. The general idea is that you can use this to play PC games. Here's how it works. You'll connect your device to your PC using this app. It then uses head tracking and integrates it directly into the game that you're playing. The game is then streamed to your headset which emulates a VR experience. This gives a pseudo-VR experience that is actually fairly unique. Things can be a bit jumpy when you're actually using it, so be sure to use the free demo first to make sure your system and device can handle it!

Voxel Fly VR.

Price: Free / \$3.99.

Voxel Fly VR is an endless runner title that puts the thrill of the run right in your face. In this game, you'll be flying through an endless city while avoiding traffic and various obstacles to see how far you can go. It has leaderboards so you can compare with friends to see who can make it the furthest. You'll also get various difficulty modes, a 2D mode, support for game pads and various control schemes, achievements, and support for a wide variety of Cardboard variants. It's fairly intense which makes it a great experience for VR and it's completely free to play.

VR Controller.

Price: \$3.99.

VR Controller isn't actually a VR game but it can help you play them. How it works is you use this on an old or unused device and it turns that device into a Bluetooth controller. You can then use that controller on VR games that require one (like many on this list do). It was developed for the Samsung Gear VR but the developers claim that it supports Google Cardboard and other Android-powered VR headsets as well. It'll run you \$3.99 but we urge you to try it out quickly so make sure that it works before the refund time runs out.

VR X-Racer.

Price: Free / \$5.01.

VR X-Racer is an infinite runner game where you're tasked with avoiding obstacles while traveling very quickly. You'll get points for things like near misses and hitting blue rings that appear in your path and your goal is to get the highest possible score while traveling as far as possible. It's relatively simple compared to some other games on the list. However, it does give you the option to play with a game pad or with head tracking as your controller. It's free to download and play with the in-app purchases accounting for upgrades like no advertising.

Whispering Eons.

Price: Free.

Whispering Eons is one of the few good free Google Cardboard games. It's an adventure game with space opera and puzzle elements. Players move and interact with various elements of the game world to solve puzzles, talk to people, and figure out the story. The cut scenes are actually quite good and the game play is above average. It's only about an hour long and we think it should have been longer. However, it's difficult to complain much about a free game. It works best with Google Cardboard and similar VR headsets. However, there is an optional 3D mode to play without one as well. This is about as good as it gets for a free game.

Wrong Voyage VR.

Price: Free.

Wrong Voyage is a hybrid between a puzzle game, a platformer, and there are even some FPS elements baked in. You're playing as someone who has discovered a strange ruin and your job is to explore it. You'll use your weapon to make platforms move about and you'll have to safely navigate the terrain without falling off. The game should work on most Cardboard variants along with other Android-powered VR headsets. About the only caveat is that you are required to have a Bluetooth controller in order to play the game. Otherwise, it's completely free to download and play. It's worth noting that this developer has four other VR games that are also pretty decent.
