How to Sync Photos from iPhone to Computer.

Photos hold valuable memories that might as well be priceless for the phone owner. Such a trend has caused technology to come up with different ways to store photos in iPhone and sync photos from iPhone to computer for safe keeping.

iPhone users are not strangers to this set-up. As a matter of fact, iPhone users have several options as to how they'd like to sync and keep copies of the photos they've taken with their phones right into their computer. Part 1: Two ways to sync photos from iPhone to PC.

To sync all photos from iPhone to PC, we recommend you to use dr.fone. This transfer can help you to sync photos including Camera Roll, Photo Library and Photo Stream. Besides, you can also use it to transfer music, videos, audiobooks and others from iDevice to PC or iTunes and back. Just take a trial.

Just see the below simple steps for syncing photos from iPhone to PC:

Step 1. Connect iPhone to your computer. And launch dr.fone. You will see your device information in the main interface.

Step 2. Go to the "Photos" tab, and open Camera Roll, Photo Library, or Photo Stream tab to view your photos.

Step 3. Simply select the photos you want in any tab and click "Export to" to sync iPhone photos to computer.

If you are to use a Windows PC to keep copies of the photos you have taken in your iPhone, then you will probably find it easy to do so. Windows supports direct sync or transfer for your photos from your iPhone, and it applies to any of your iOS devices as well.

Step 1. Connect your iPhone to your PC. It is preferred that you use the USB cable that came with your iPhone's original packaging so as to avoid any hardware problems or issues that may arise during transfer or sync. Once your iPhone is connected, an AutoPlay window will appear, prompting you to choose among the different options available for your iPhone. In this case, under Device options, we will select Import pictures and videos.

Step 2. From this point onwards, Windows will guide you and before the syncing starts, you will be asked to select the photos, and even videos, that you would want to store in your PC. After making your selection, Windows will start transferring or syncing your photos along with your selected videos, if there are any, to your computer.

Step 3. Windows also gives you an additional option to erase the photos and videos you have selected after you've imported them to your computer. To avail of this feature, simply tick the only checkbox you see in the window displaying the status of your syncing or importing.

Step 4. Once all your photos, along with your videos, have been synced, you may now carefully disconnect your iPhone from your PC.

Part 2: The easiest way to sync photos from iPhone to Mac.

If you own a Mac and are planning to sync photos from iPhone to Mac, you are definitely in luck as you have quite a handful of available methods to choose from. However, we'll be discussing only one method involving the use of quality third-party applications to help you do the trick.

There are quite a number of third-party software to sync iPhone photos to Mac, but it's always better to go for the highly-recommended ones. For the set of instructions that you'll be seeing below, we'll be using dr.fone for Mac to sync photos from iPhone to Mac.

Just follow these instructions to get your iPhone photos stored in your Mac:

Step 1. Get your iPhone and connect it to your Mac with a cable. Launch dr.fone and it should automatically detect your iPhone. At the main window of dr.fone, your iPhone's information will be displayed as the picture below.

Step 2. Now select the "Photos" tab. This will prompt dr.fone to scan your iPhone for all photos that are stored in it – including those from Camera Roll, Photo Stream, and Photo library, and display them in the main pane of the window. Just select the photos and click "Export" to sync photos from iPhone to Mac.

Step 3. Alternatively, if you want to transfer ALL of the photos on your device to Mac, you can just click on the "Backup Photos to Mac" option. You can refer to this Guide.

Method 1. Transfer Files from iPhone to PC with iTunes File Sharing

Applies To: Documents created by Keynotes, Numbers, Pages, or other apps that work with File Sharing.

iTunes File Sharing is mainly designed to share files between your computer and a supported app on your iPhone/iPad. If you are sure the files you want to transfer are created by an app that works is compatible with File Sharing, you can transfer content from iPhone to computer using this feature.

iTunes File Sharing allows you to transfer files from iPhone to PC using a USB cable or over a Wi-Fi connection. If you prefer to send files over Wi-Fi, you need to set up Wi-Fi syncing first according to the guide provided by Apple.

To copy files from iPhone to PC with iTunes File Sharing using USB:

Step 1. Connect your iPhone your computer and launch iTunes if it doesn't run automatically.

Step 2. In the iTunes window, click the "Device" tab and select "File Sharing".

Step 3. Select the app shown in the list from which you want to transfer files to PC.

Step 4. Select the files you want to move to computer and click "Save to".

Step 5. Select a location to save the items and click "Save to" to start transferring files from your iPhone to the computer.

Method 2. Copy Files from iPhone to PC with iPhone Transfer Software.

Applies To: Photos, Videos, Audio Files, Contacts, Messages, Podcasts, Books.

With it, you can not only transfer files from iPhone to PC but also add contents to your iPhone from computer. Besides, you are able to transfer data from one iOS device to another using this tool. To transfer files from iPhone to PC:

Step 1. Connect your iPhone to your PC with a USB cable. Then launch EaseUS MobiMover and go to "Phone to PC" > "Next".

Step 2. Check the types of files you want to transfer and click "Transfer". You can specify a location to keep the transferred items in advance. Otherwise, they will be placed on Desktop by default.

Step 3. Wait for the transfer process to finish. When it has done, go to the selected folder to check the items.

Method 3. Transfer Files between iPhone and Your Computer via iCloud Drive.

Applies To: Excel, Word, PowerPoint Files.

As you may know, iCloud Drive is an option in iCloud and is helpful to sync documents across your devices on which iCloud Drive is enabled. To transfer files from iPhone to PC using iCloud Drive, you first need to add the items to iCloud Drive on your iPhone and then access or download them on the computer. Here are the details:

To copy files from iPhone to PC with iCloud Drive:

Step 1. On the iOS device, go to the "Settings" app and select [your name] > "iCloud".

Step 2. Scroll down to enable "iCloud Drive".

Step 3. Open the "Files" app and select "Browse" > "iCloud Drive". Search for the files you attempt to copy to your PC and upload them to iCloud Drive.

Step 4. If you have downloaded and set up iCloud for Windows, go to the iCloud Drive folder in File Explorer to access the files from your iPhone. If not, go to iCloud.com, sign in with your Apple ID, choose "iCloud Drive" among the options and then select and download the files to your PC.

While using iCloud services, you may encounter issues like "iCloud Drive not syncing". If you do, stay calm and follow the troubleshooting guide to solve the problem.

Method 4. Import Files from iPhone to PC Using iCloud.

Applies To: Photos, Contacts, Calendars, Reminders, Notes, and more.

If you want to transfer files from iPhone to computer wirelessly, using iCloud to sync data from your iOS device to a PC or Mac is what you will like. The requirements for using iCloud include the same Apple ID on the devices, stable network connection, and enough iCloud storage space. Make sure the requirements are met and then follow the steps below to transfer files from your photo library, contact list, and more to the computer using iCloud.

To download files from iPhone to PC:

If you have installed iCloud for Windows:

Step 1. Open "Settings" on your iPhone and go to [your name] > "iCloud".

Step 2. Toggle on the option accordingly. For example, if you want to transfer photos from iPhone to PC, select the "Photos" option and turn on "iCloud Photos".

Step 3. Open iCloud for Windows on your computer and turn on the corresponding option. Then you can access the files on your iPhone from PC.

If you didn't install iCloud for Windows:

Step 1. Open "Settings" on your iPhone, go to [your name] > "iCloud" and turn on the option according to the file you want to transfer.

Step 2. On your PC, go to [iCloud.com](https://www.icloud.com) and sign in with the Apple ID you use on the iPhone.

Step 3. Select the category you intend to copy.

Step 4. Choose the items you want to transfer and then download them to your PC.

Method 5. Transfer Files from iPhone to PC via Dropbox.

Applies To: Photos, Videos, Audios, Documents.

Dropbox, like iCloud, is a cloud service that helps you transfer files without using a USB cable. Instead, you need to download and install the Dropbox app on both your source device and target device to upload and download the files you want to share.

To move files from iPhone to PC with Dropbox:

Step 1. Download and install Dropbox on your devices and sign in with the same account.

Step 2. To transfer files from iPhone to PC, upload the items to Dropbox on your iOS device first. If you transfer a file from PC to iPhone, upload the file to Dropbox from PC.

Step 3. Go to Dropbox on your PC and then you can see the files you just uploaded. Select the items and download them to your computer.

Method 6. Transfer Photos from iPhone to Windows via File Explorer.

Applies To: Photos and Videos in Camera Roll.

If the content you are looking to copy is photos and videos in your iPhone camera roll, the easiest way for you is to use Windows File Explorer. It allows you to transfer photos and videos from iPhone to PC directly via a USB cable. No third-party software is needed.

To transfer photos from iPhone to PC:

Step 1. Connect the iOS device to PC with a USB cable.

Step 2. Unlock the iPhone and trust the computer.

Step 3. Go to "This PC" > "[your iPhone name]" > "Internal Storage" > "DCIM" > "100APPLE".

Step 4. Manually copy the photos and videos you want to transfer from your iPhone to PC.

If you need to, you can also learn other ways on how to transfer photos from iPhone to PC.

Bonus Tip: How to Transfer Files from PC to iPhone.

You may currently need to copy files from iPhone to PC. But there will be times when you will need to transfer files from PC to iPhone. Step 1. Connect the iPhone to the computer with a USB cable.

Step 2. After iTunes recognizes the iPhone, click "Device" and select the category you want to transfer.

Step 3. Check the "Sync [category]" option and select the items you want to copy.

Step 4. Click "Apply" to start syncing files from PC to iPhone.

How to transfer photos to iPhone using iTunes.

The first app that comes to mind when you think about transferring photos to iPhone is, of course, iTunes. Apple-based solution, it will allow you to transfer files to your iPhone quickly. However, as with so many Apple products, the whole process is tainted by some weird-flavoured magic, leaving behind a bitter taste and a silent question of whether it was really worth it.

We would not recommend using this method because of the following disadvantages:

- You will only be able to sync one folder at any time. If you change the folder later, your previous images will be erased.
- The operation will erase all the images previously stored in Photo Library (your Camera Roll photos will stay intact).
- Images in the Photo Library can only be changed/deleted from the PC, and iTunes won't let you delete the images separately – only do a full resync. To be able to create and edit the content of albums inside Photo Library, you can use CopyTrans Photo.
- The sync will not be automatic anyway. You will need to relaunch it every time you need to introduce changes.

Some disadvantages:

Top 4 Ways to Transfer Photos from iPhone to PC Without iTunes.

Transferring photos from an iPhone to PC can be a cumbersome experience. After all, it's not as straightforward as with Android phones where you just need to plug it and use the phone storage to move the pictures. With iOS, one needs to use iTunes to transfer photos from iPhone to a Windows PC.

Installing and dealing with iTunes is not something every Windows PC user enjoys. And most of us believe that it is the only way to transfer photos. Thankfully, we've figured out a couple of options. In this post, we will discuss 4 alternate ways to move your pictures from iPhone to PC without iTunes.

OneDrive.

OneDrive is a cloud storage offering by Microsoft. First, you need to download OneDrive app from the App Store. Then go to photos app, select images and upload them to the OneDrive app. You can also turn on automatic camera upload option from the OneDrive app's settings menu. That way all your recently added photos will be uploaded to OneDrive Camera folder automatically.

Open OneDrive app, go to settings, select options and switch on camera upload. Don't forget to turn on the Upload in Background toggle. It will make sure that the whole process works flawlessly even if the app is closed and not open in multitasking menu.

You can access the recently uploaded photos from the OneDrive app for Windows 10. And even better, the default Photos app on Windows 10 also lets you access OneDrive images. Simply turn on 'Show cloud-only content from OneDrive' toggle from the settings menu of Microsoft Photos.

The above trick also applies to Dropbox (native Windows 10 app) and Google Drive (Desktop Sync tool), but the reason I chose OneDrive is because of its smooth integration with the Photos app for Windows 10 and the fact that it comes pre-installed with the operating system.

Google Photos.

Google Photos is an excellent photo service. The Google Photos app not only lets you upload unlimited photos (in specific resolutions) for free but also adds AI algorithms to organize them. As you continue to feed Google Photos with your images, it categorizes them based on what AI sees in it and adds relevant tags to people, objects, pets, food, documents and more.

Once you take a backup of your snaps to Google Photos app, visit Google Photos webpage and access all the images from a familiar UI. Right-click on any photo and download the pictures to a PC.

Continue on PC.

Continue on PC is a nifty little trick to send any link to a PC. Follow our guide on using Continue on PC with your default browser to set it up on your PC.

Once done, you need to follow these steps:

Step 1: Open Google Photos app and select pictures.

Step 2: Tap on the share button to generate a shareable link.

Step 3: The app will upload the images to Google Photos server and generate a link for it.

Step 4: Share that link using Continue on PC app.

Step 5: Select your PC in the list and the link will open in the Microsoft Edge browser on your PC.

Step 6: The selected photos will now open in Edge browser and from there you can download it to your PC.

This hack is the quickest way to transfer photos from iPhone to PC.

Xender.

If you don't want to mess around with cloud storage options (at some point you'll have to pay for those services if you want a full quality photo backup) or are uncomfortable with big companies holding your data, then Xender is your best bet.

You must have heard about Xender or used it in the past while transferring data from one phone to another. But very few know about its capability to do the same from any phone to PC.

The app was riddled with ads earlier, which fortunately isn't the case anymore. To transfer the photos, follow these steps.

Step 1: Open Xender app and give it access to media files on the phone.

Step 2: Tap on the profile icon at the upper left corner and select 'Connect to PC' option.

Step 3: The app will ask you to open Xender Web in the browser on your PC.

Step 4: Visit Xender Web on PC and scan the QR code with the Xender mobile app.

Step 5: You will see the screen with photos, videos, and documents from the phone.

This trick also lets you move large video files, songs, and documents to PC. I tried to transfer a 1.3GB video file to PC which took less than two minutes to complete. Also, you can move data from PC to phone. To do that, select media files on PC and use drag and drop trick to move them to the Xender web.

Choose any of the above solutions, and you will be fine without downloading iTunes on your PC. If you are an Office 365 subscriber, then go with OneDrive as it comes with 1TB of storage. Google Photos is a free option and gets the job done as well.

The Continue on PC is nifty but mostly useful when you want to transfer a few photos in a hurry. It's not logical to use with large files. Free download MacX MediaTrans (macOS Big Sur also supported) or download Windows version for free (Win 10), and run it.

Step 1: Connect your iPhone to Mac/PC with USB cable and turn off iTunes auto sync.

Step 2: Click "Photo Transfer" on the main interface. It's quite on-screen instruction to copy photos from iPhone.

You can add photos to iPhone via "Add Photo" button.

It's the same to transfer photos from iPad to Mac/PC. The iPhone photo downloader can transfer music, videos, movies, TV shows from iPhone, iPad, iPod to Mac/PC and vice versa. Plus, it can turn your iPhone, iPad to a USB flash drive to store any data.

When you download HEIC photos from iPhone, you are free to use the software to convert HEIC image to JPG format for Android devices, or older iPhone models, image editors, Windows PC.

If you are Amazon Prime member, you can turn to Amazon Cloud Drive Photos to import photos from iPhone. Amazon Cloud Drive gives unlimited photo backup, and other storage start at \$ 11.99/year.

You are allowed to download photos from iPhone to Mac/PC/external hard drive via Amazon Drive desktop. After you import photos from iPhone to Amazon drive, select Downloads tab, click Download..., and choose picture folder, click Download to... and select a destination folder to save pictures from iPhone to Mac/PC/hard drive/USB flash drive.

Shortcomings: It can only copy photos from iPhone, without any other advanced options, for example, delete photos from iPhone in batch, organize photos into folders, and more. Other photo organizing software for iPhone is needed for better photo management.

3. Download iPhone Pictures with Email.

You can do as follows to download photos from iPhone to Mac/PC: 1. Open iPhone photo app and select photos you want to download. 2. Tap Mail icon, enter email address and click Send. 3. Login in email address on Mac/PC and download images you've sent from from iPhone.

Shortcomings: It's an old-fashioned way to import photos from iPhone, especially when there're tons of photo transfer applications available. You can only send up to five photos each time. Image quality gets decreased during the process.

4. Sync Photos from iPhone to Mac with Image Capture.

Image Capture is one of wonderful Apple's applications that many iPhone users don't bother with. In fact, you can use it to save photos from iPhone to Mac/iPhone/iPad/Android in a very simple way.

To download photos from iPhone to iMac/MacBook Air/Pro: 1. Connect iPhone to computer, run Image Capture, select iPhone in the Devices list. 2. Press CMD +A to select all the images on iPhone, or press CMD + to select a few pictures at random. 3. Choose "Import" or "Import All" to import photos from iPhone to Mac computer. You can select "Delete after Import" to remove pics on iPhone after you've synced them to Mac/Windows PCs.

Shortcomings: Image Capture only enables you to copy photos from iPhone to Mac without deleting the original files on iPhone. It has no photo editing features that iPhoto offers. Note that it merely helps download iPhone photos from Camera roll, not including other photo albums on iPhone.

5. Import Photos from iPhone with iPhoto.

Get to know how to transfer photos from iPhone to Mac/iPhone/iPad etc. 1. Connect iPhone with Mac computer via USB cable, and run iPhoto on Mac. 2. Head to Device and find your iPhone. 3. Select photo on iPhone to download, there're two options: import selected, or import all.

Shortcomings: iPhoto accepts most common image file formats. iPhoto is not working on Mac OS X Yosemite and higher version, discontinued. Check iPhoto alternatives if you need.

6. Transfer Images from iPhone with AirDrop.

AirDrop can transfer photos from iPhone to iPhone, iPad, Mac, iPod, requiring no software installation, no password. But it is not good for large amounts of photo transfer from iPhone. To use AirDrop to export iPhone photos:

1. Turn on AirDrop on your iPhone by using Control Center. Please note that Airdrop supports to import photos from iPhone 5 or later. 2. Select photo and tap Airdrop icon. 3. Choose iPhone, iPad, Mac, iPod setc. to copy photos from iPhone to.

You have many other optional ways to download photos from iPhone to PC/Mac/iPhone/iPad/USB drive: iTunes, iCloud, photo app like iPhoto, Windows Explorer (import photos from iPhone to Windows 10), Dropbox cloud services. But the first iPhone photo transfer third-party tool is the fastest way to copy photos from iPhone in batch with no limits.
